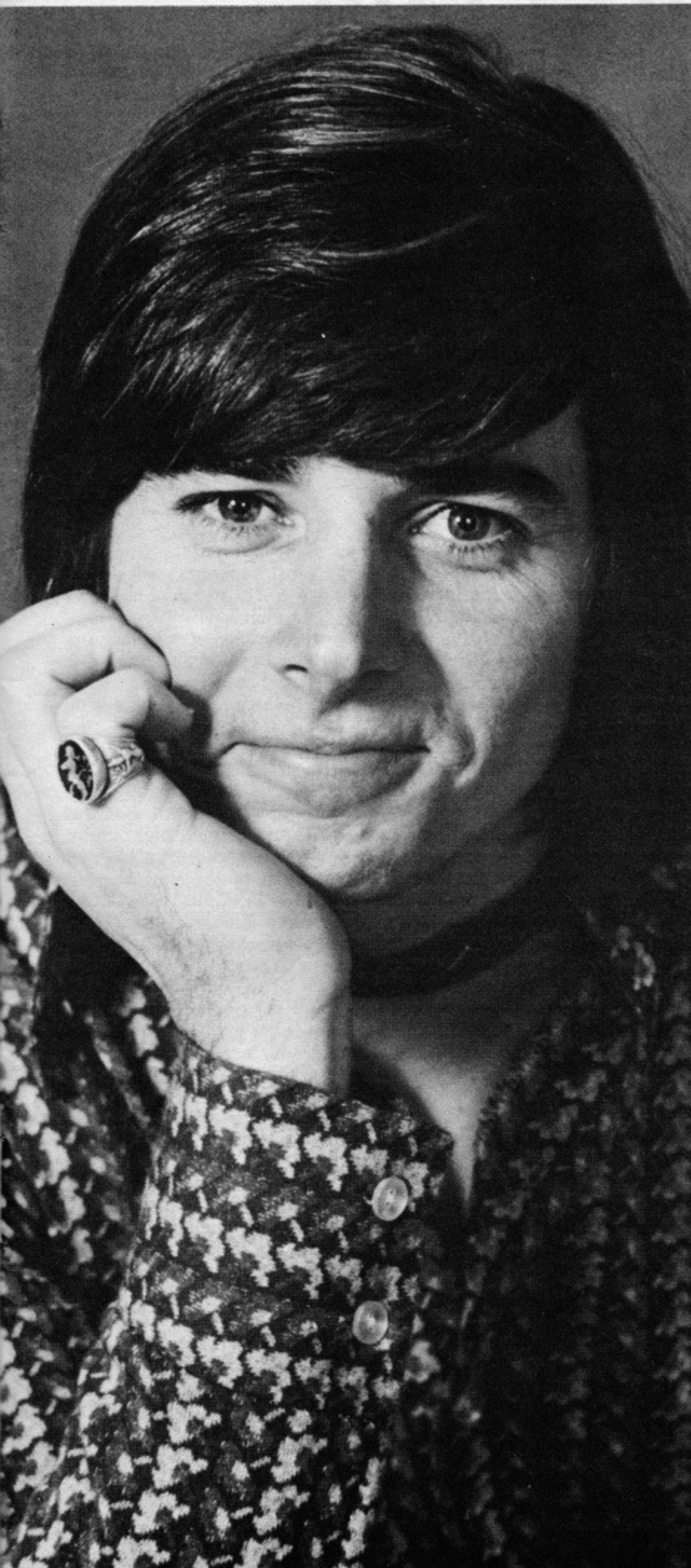


The Girl They Love!
