

ON THE SET WITH DAVID CONTINUED

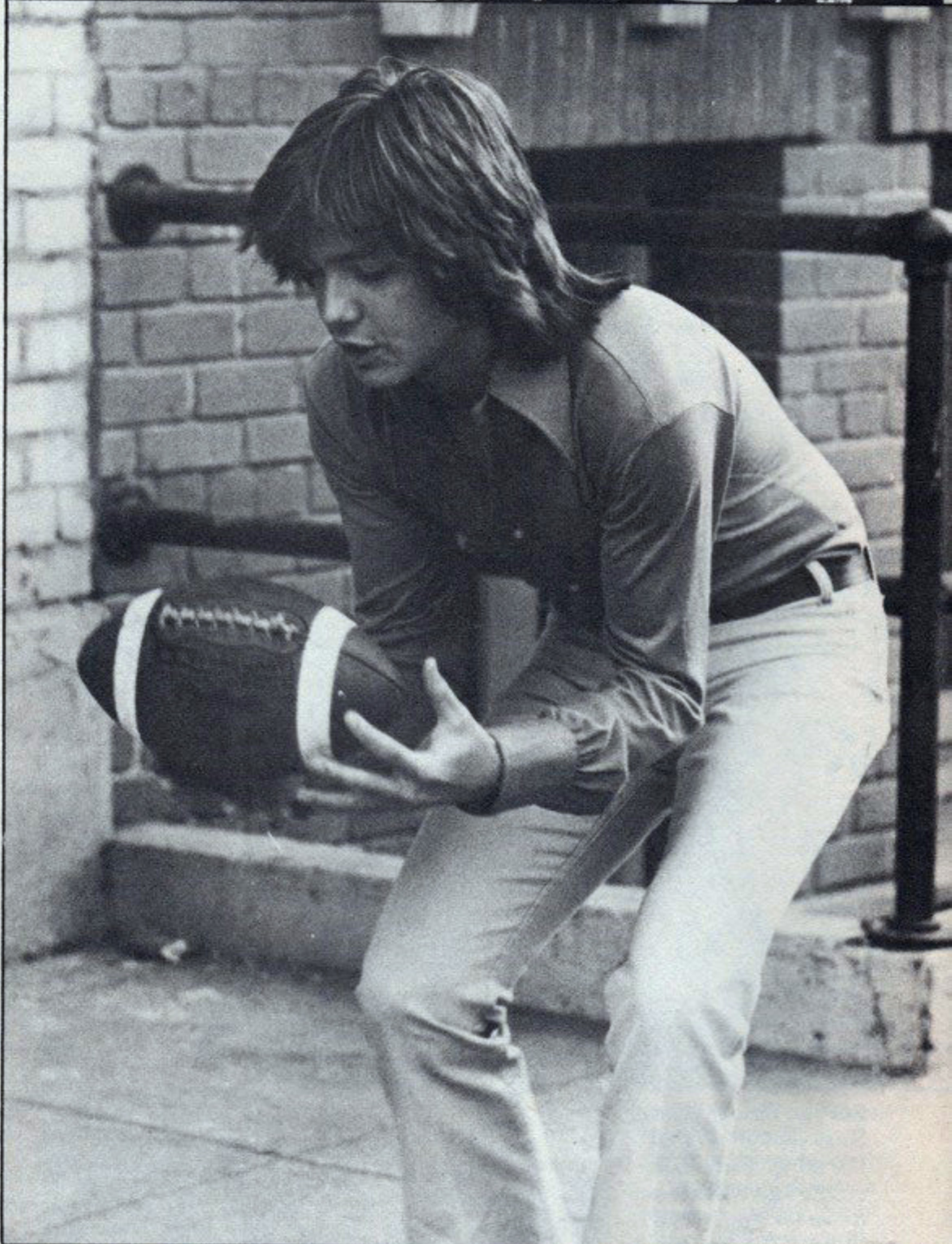
