'Little Oscarettie'.")

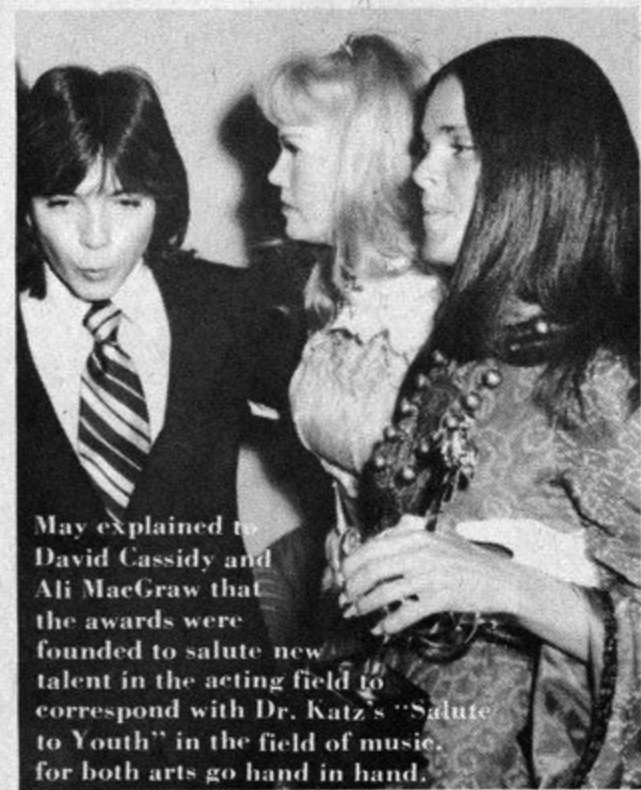
The Oscarettie Committee intends next year to put a sign on the Los Angeles City Hall Tower (Mayor Yorty permitting), announcing the "Oscarettie" date in advance. Due to the capacity of the beautiful Scottish Rites Theater, 2000 seats, and fire laws, over two thousand people, in spite of their engraved invitations, were turned away. I hear we've now been offered "The Forum" in Inglewood for 1972. Since there is no admission charge, and all expenses are borne by Dr. Katz and the Junior Philharmonic and The Oscarettie Committee, publicity is not given out until the actual event itself. That is to keep the crowds in control. Last year helicopters and police worked frantically to clear the streets leading to the Scottish Rites

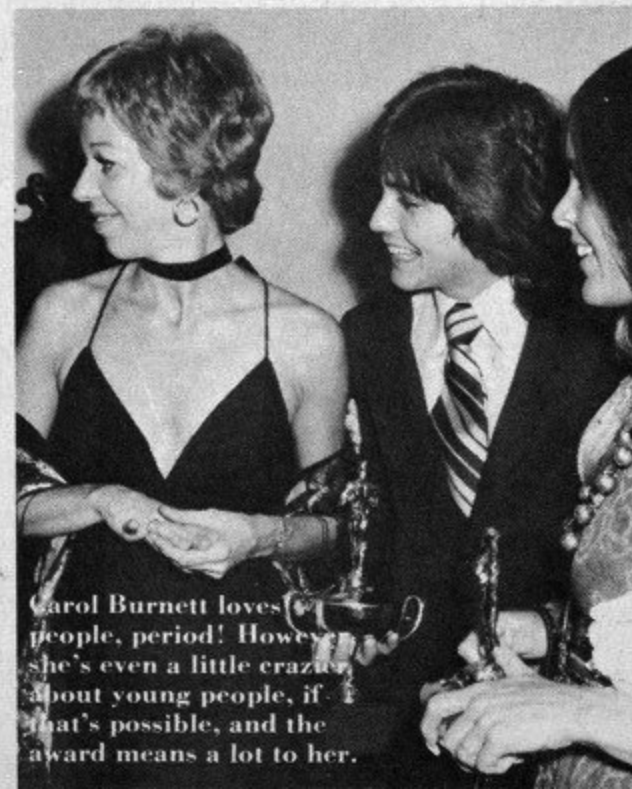
