the guitar and then other instruments and tried for years to become a star. He got to be a musician, much in demand, but faceless, until he was given a vote of confidence by Capitol Records and allowed to cut a record as a vocalist. Then he hooked up with the Smothers Brothers, and since has un-hooked himself when he took issue concerning the political humor the brothers smothered themselves in. Glen, a member of a family boasting 12 children, will probably earn well over the \$2 million he made last year from personal appearances, record dates, and film work!

Charley Pride, pride of RCA, is probably the only black star to make it big in country music. He started out in the Mississippi cotton fields where he spent a bone breaking childhood working alongside his seven brothers and three sisters. When he was older he tried to break into baseball and made it with the Memphis Red Sox in the Negro American League.

After being hurt on the ballfield, Charley's career was at a finish. Was it to be the cotton fields again in the blistering sun? Was this the end? He always liked to play the guitar and singing star Red Sovine became interested in him and recommended him to Chet Atkins. He cut his first record in 1965 and today is regarded as a top moneymaker and star. Charley keeps in good physical trim and the uneasy head that wears the crown may grin and laugh, but as Pride says, "You never know in this business .
