he was sleeping and told him that Kevin was dead. So David, too, was in a state of shock. And he went to the funeral with some of his friends.

"All of us were stunned, because—well, you knew Kevin, he was very sad. His mom had died, he had gone through a lot of hassles, and he had been on his own for a long time. He had tried to commit suicide about two times prior to that, but everybody thought at the time that he was doing it for attention. I mean, I loved him and everything, but I thought it was just for attention, and David admits the same thing. We all thought it was that.

"So no one really knows what finally happened. Nobody knows if it was a suicide thing, or if it was an accident. Nobody will tell me!

"The only thing I know is that Kevin had a party on a Saturday night. He mixed alcohol with 'downers' (barbiturates) or something, and he O.D.'d. He just kept drinking more and more, so nobody knows if it was an accident. Some guy slept over, and when he woke up, there he was. . . ."

They called an ambulance, but it was too late. Kevin was dead.

His death was made even more tragic by the fact that he had given up drugs after his two suicide attempts a few years earlier. He had gone to a psychiatric institute and seemingly conquered the drug habit. In fact, Judy said, during his entire senior year at Rexford—the year they were going steady—Kevin had not touched drugs.

In fact, he was studying acting at the time he was dating Judy. "I went to his acting class with him one day," she recalls, "and he was great. He was really good. He tried out for the Los Angeles company of *Fortune And Men's Eyes* and almost won a part. But after he didn't get it, he kind of gave up. . . ."

David, too, was trying to break into acting at just about that time. And luck and determination were on his side. Although he, too, suffered rejections at first, he kept trying, until he succeeded.

But then—he had not suffered the grievous personal blows that Kevin had. David's parents, like Kevin's, were divorced, but both of David's parents are still living, while the death of Kevin's mother began the string of misfortunes which ended only with his own death. He had apparently resumed taking drugs at about the time his mother died, and that had contributed to his breakup with Judy soon after his mother's death. But Kevin and Judy remained good friends always.

David and Kevin also maintained their close friendship, and Judy recalls that David would talk to Kevin in an attempt to help him to straighten out his life, never realizing that his life had such a short course to run.

"David tried to help. And he told me that before he and Sam moved to their new house, he asked Kevin to be their roommate. . . ." Judy recalls.

But those plans were never carried out, for Kevin died. And today David and Sam live alone in the big, beautiful house in the Hollywood Hills. With one close friend gone, David continues to maintain his friendships with those he knew during his schooldays, knowing that they have always liked him for himself, and not for his newfound fame.

"Sam is a good person—a really nice guy," says Judy. "I think he's good for
