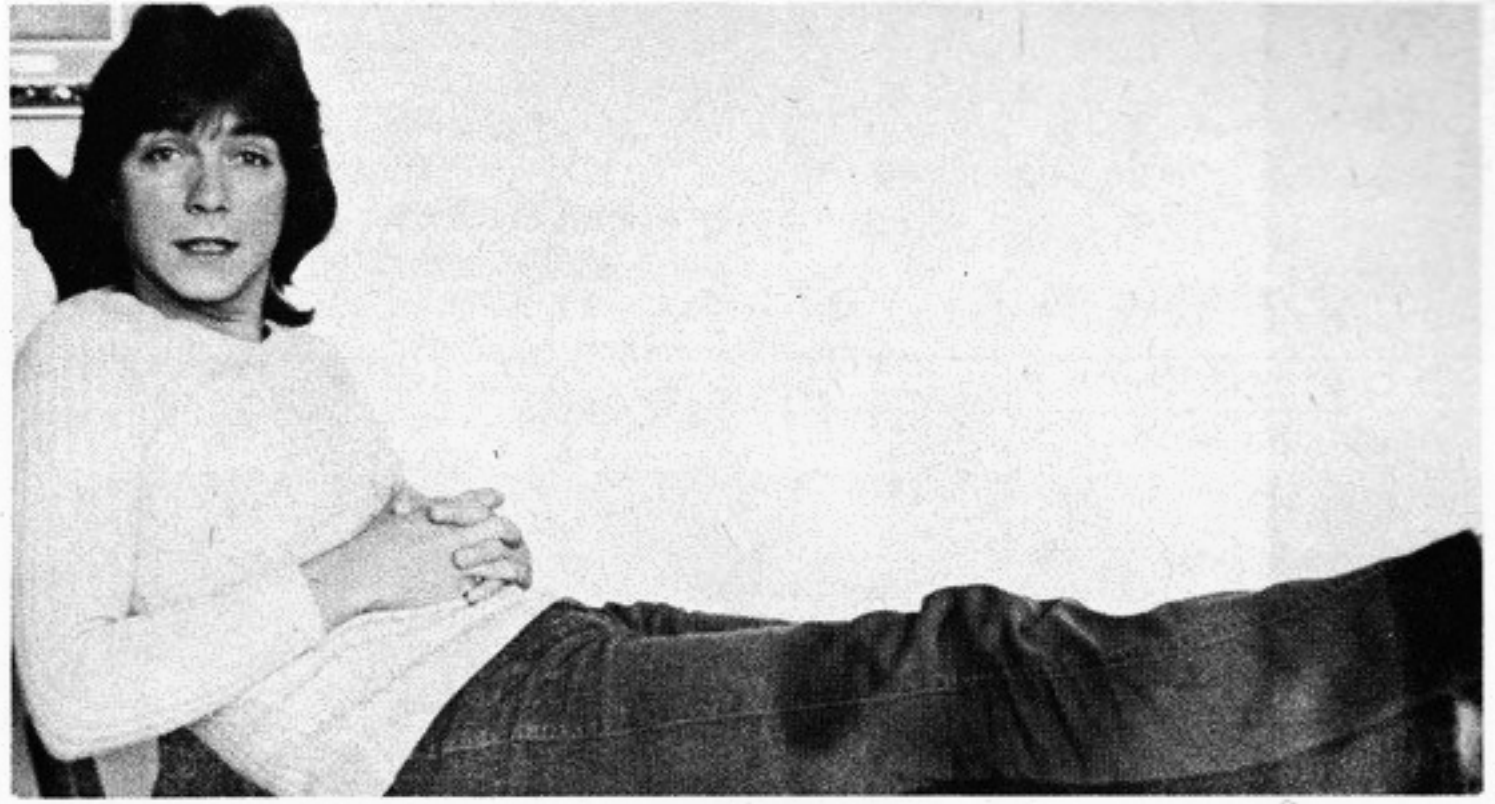




DAVID GETS SO involved with his audience that he exhausts himself!

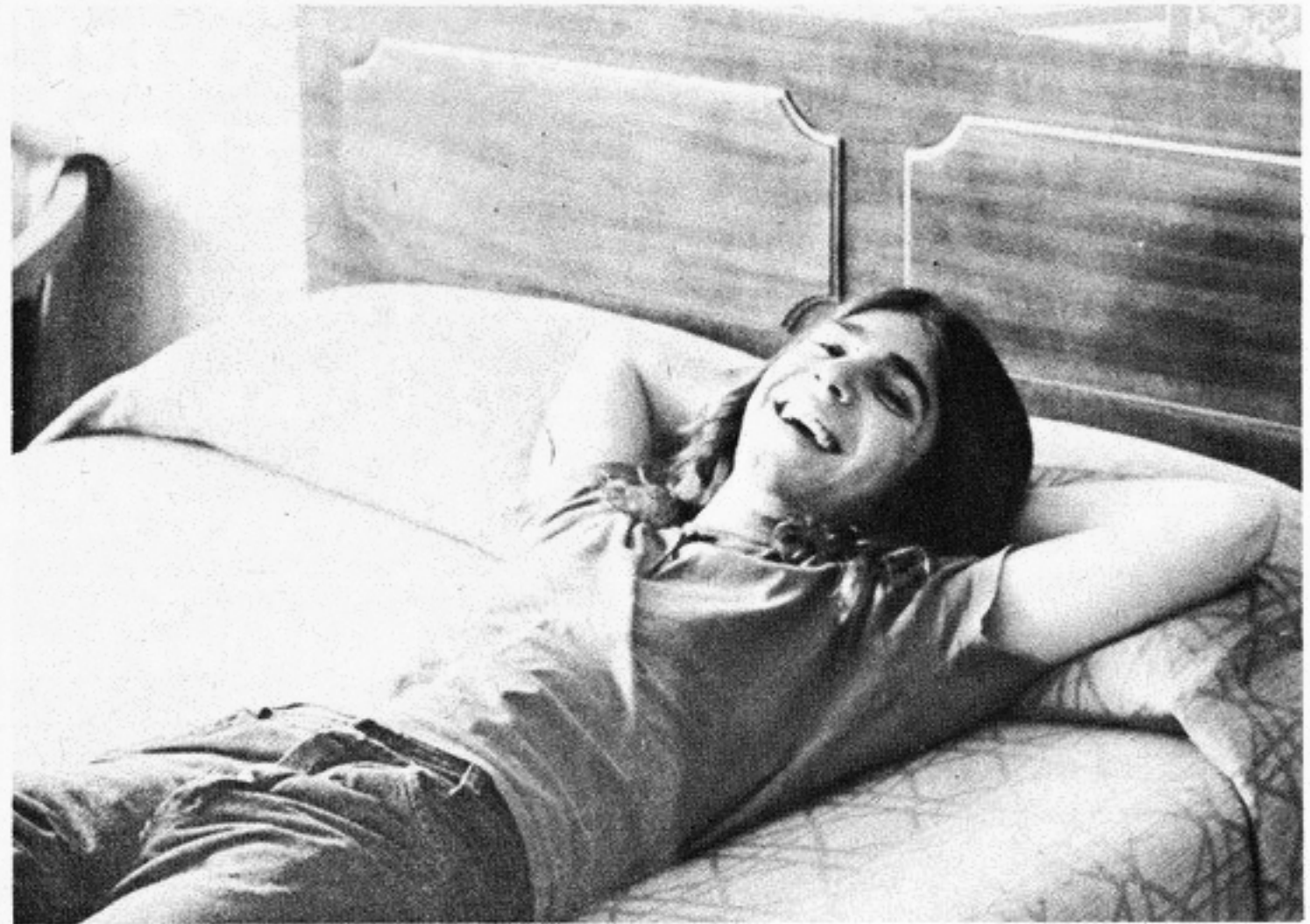
The rest of us left in the morning and the airport was jammed with David's fans—there must have been hundreds! They had come to see David off, not knowing that he had flown out the night before!
