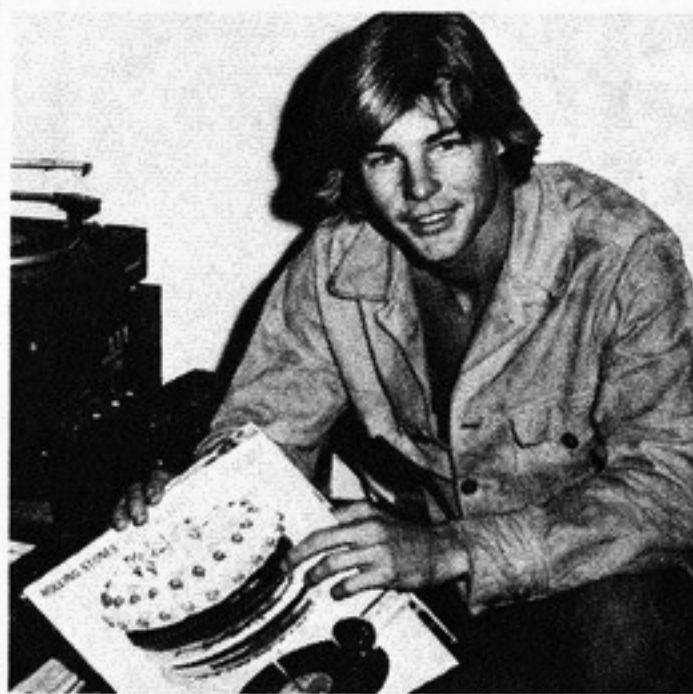
Dear FaVE,
