Hollywood and lets us all peek in!



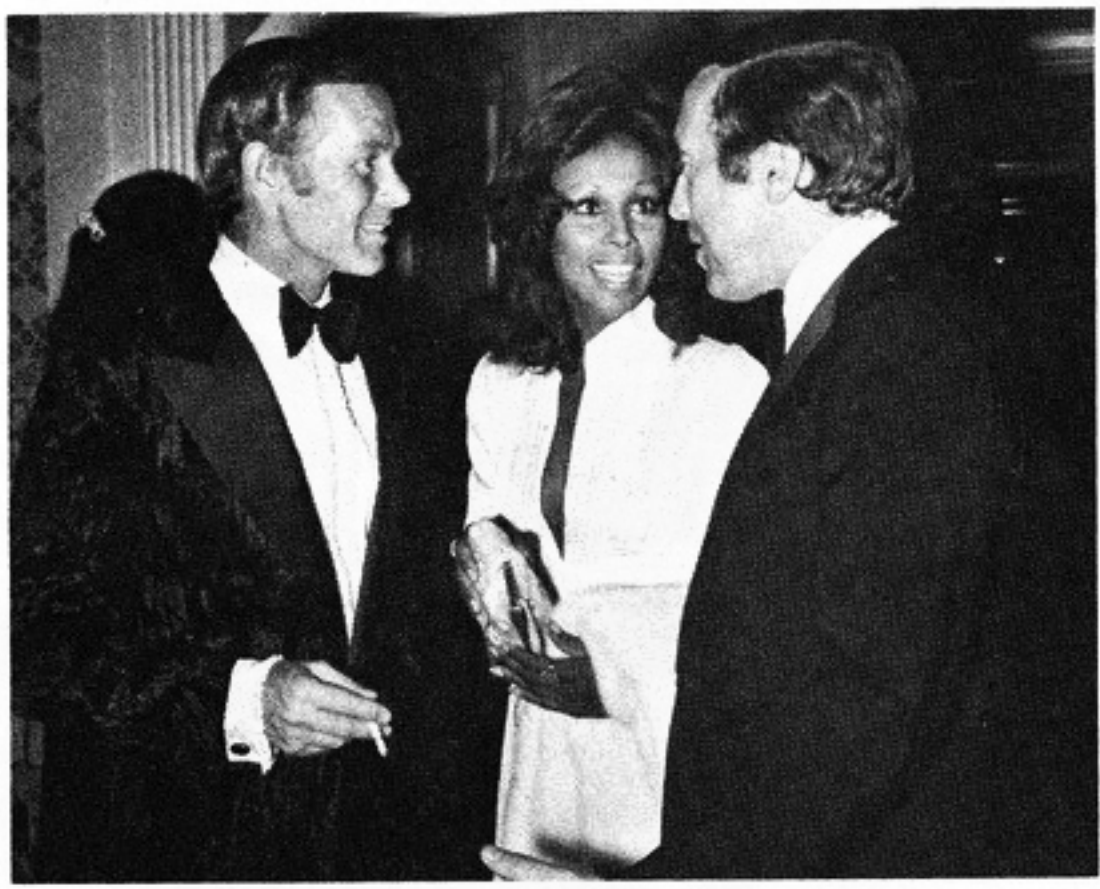
