And he's been a busy guy! His seventh movie, "Now You See Him, Now You Don't," is just being released. Plus he's just starting another season of professional baseball.

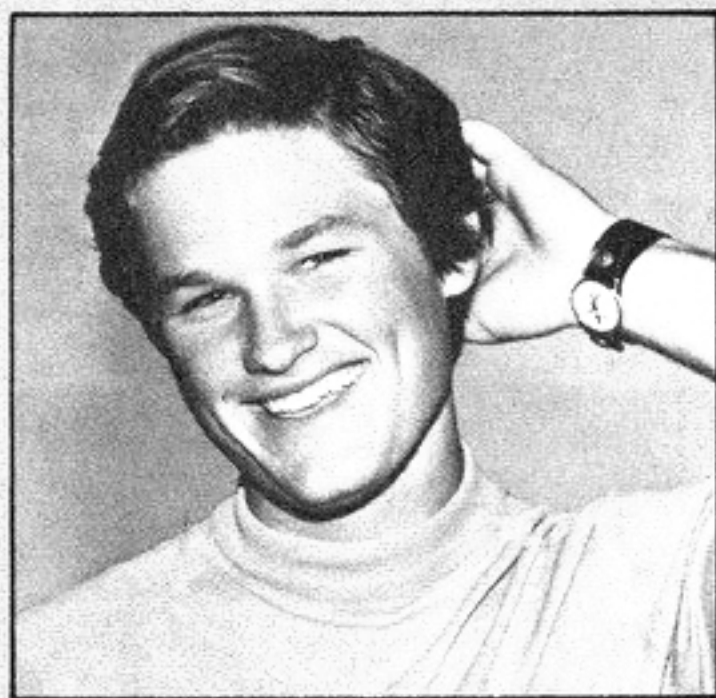
His schedule works out something like this—from June to September he plays baseball with the minor leagues. Then from September to June he's free for acting assignments.

ly explains, "I think I can arrange it so I can do both without ever having to make that final a decision. I love them both and I intend to do them both as long as I can."

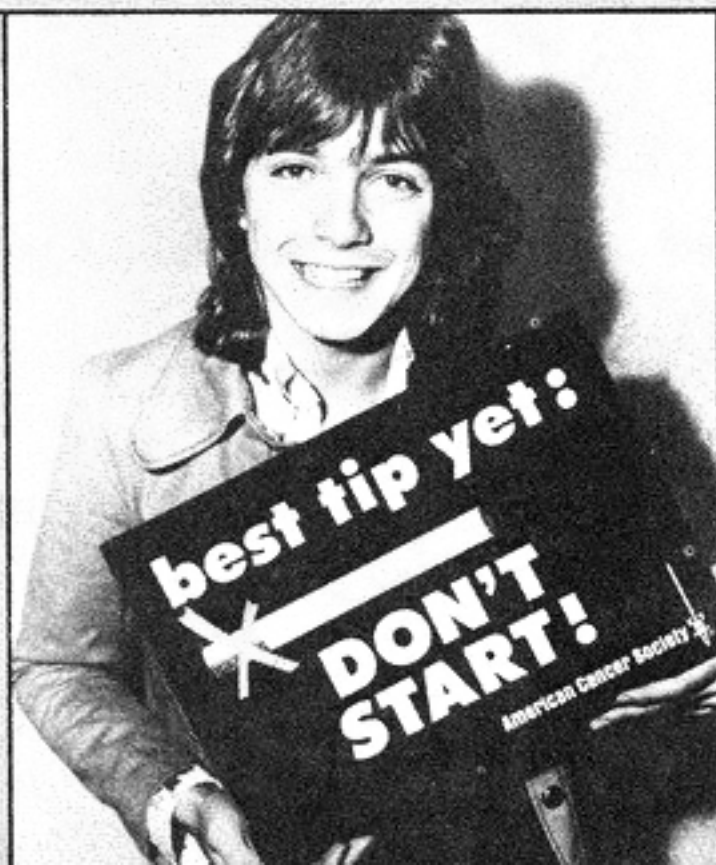
