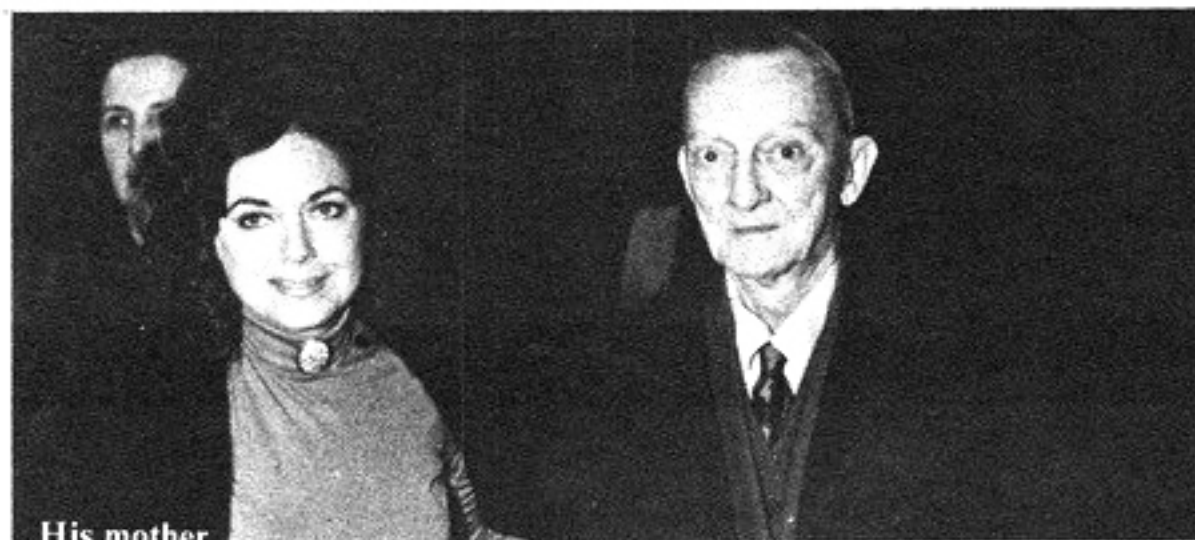


But the audience isn't enough. David likes to have his mother, Evelyn Ward on hand . . . the complete love.
