David fell face down, so when I asked him how he felt, a sound emerged from the cushions that sounded like "Mppphhnrmpfk."

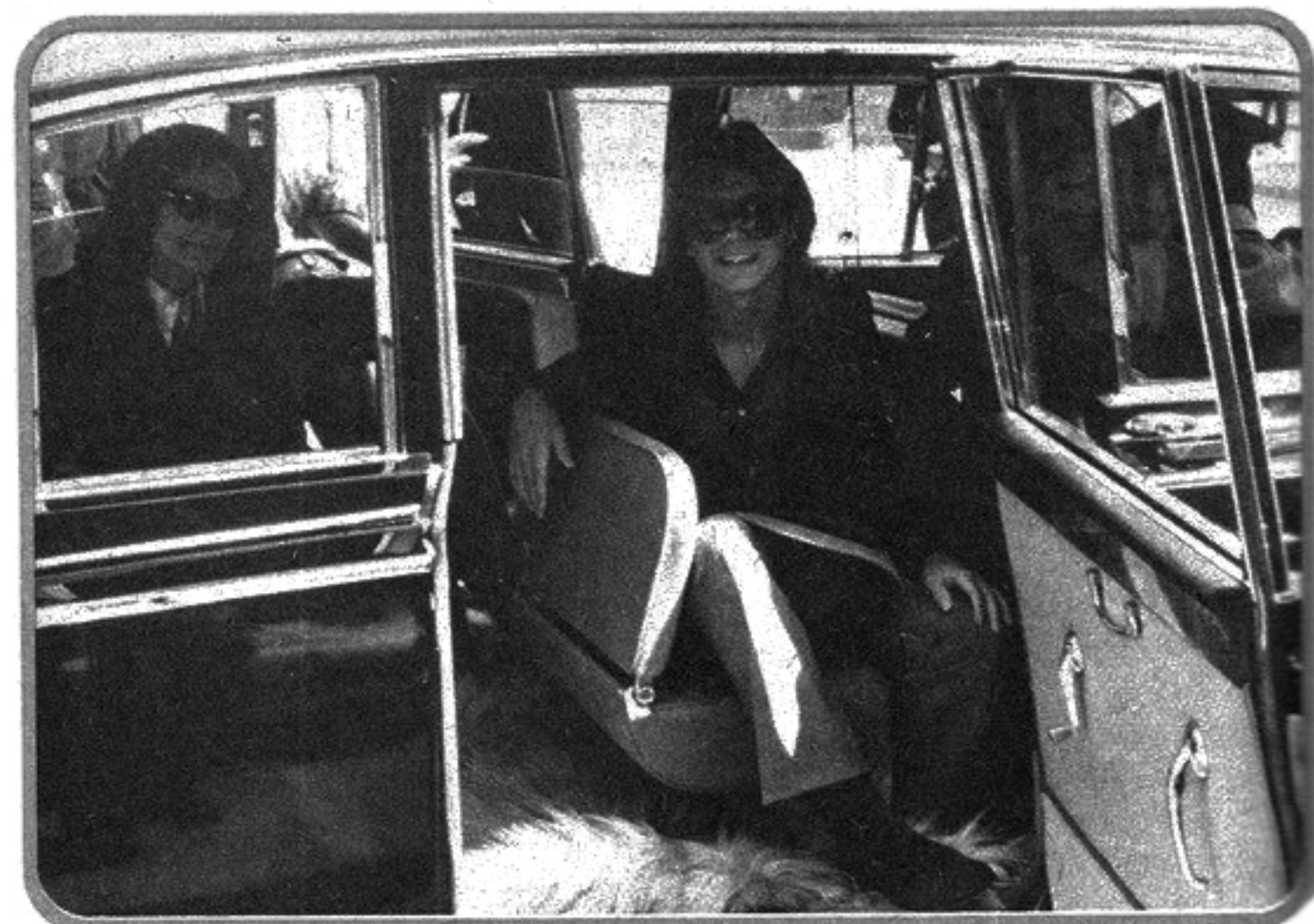
