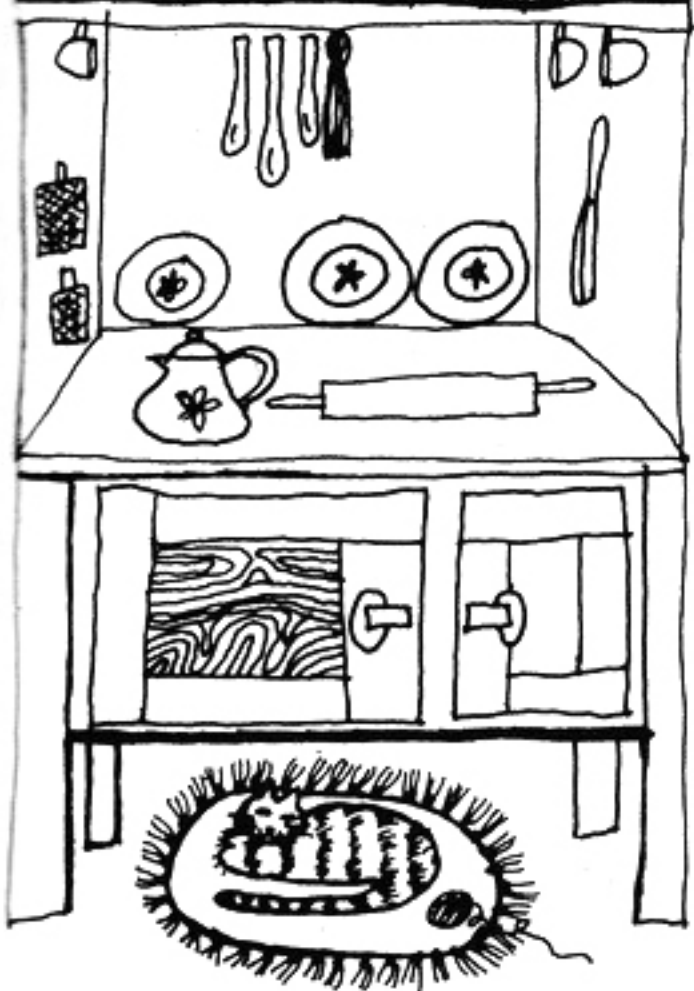


KITCHEN KORNER
