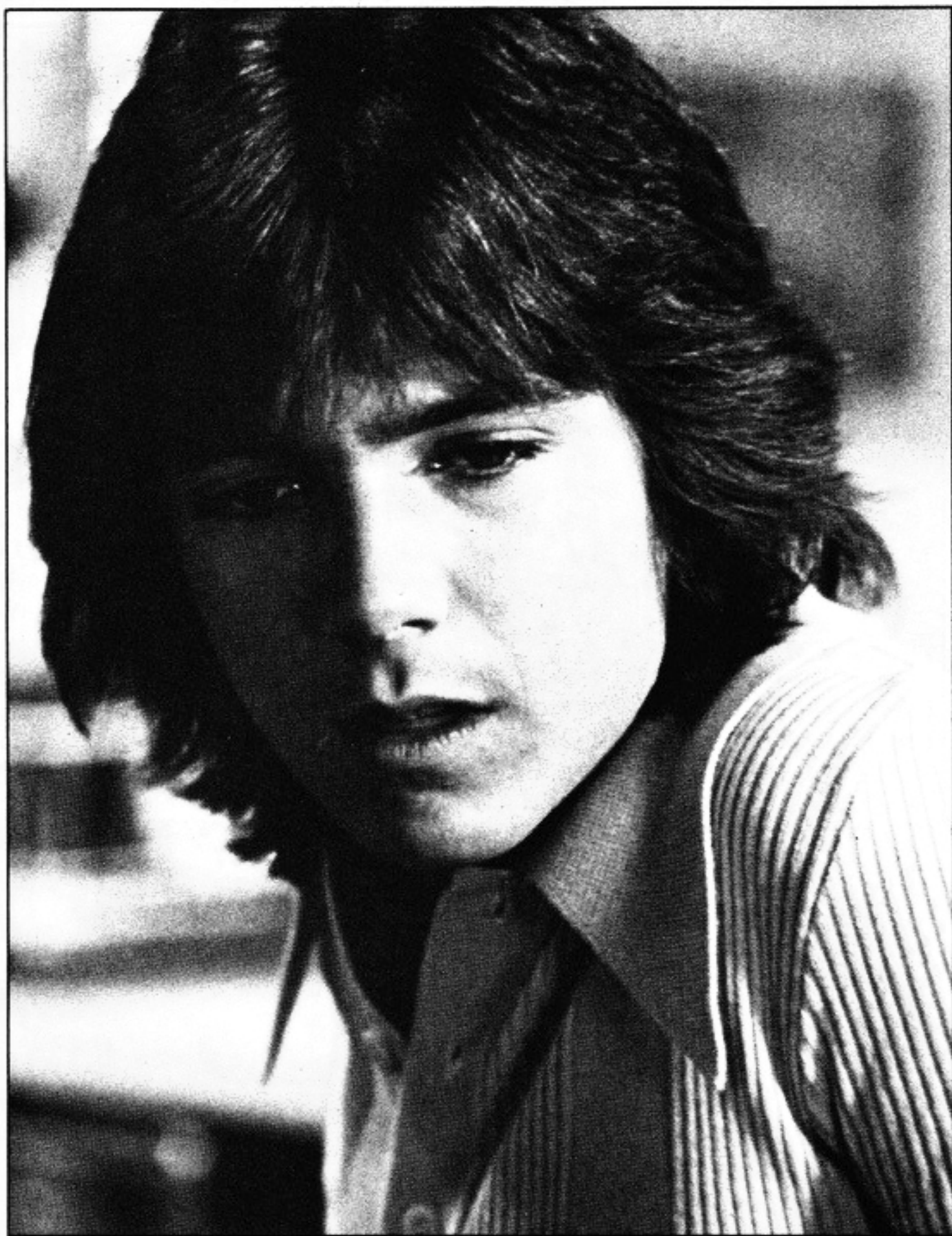


THE LONELIEST SUPERSTAR IN HOLLYWOOD
