

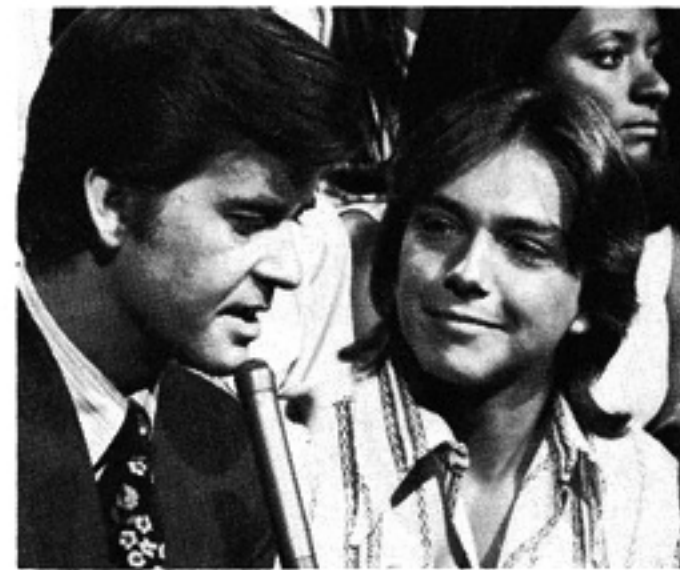
# Memories!
