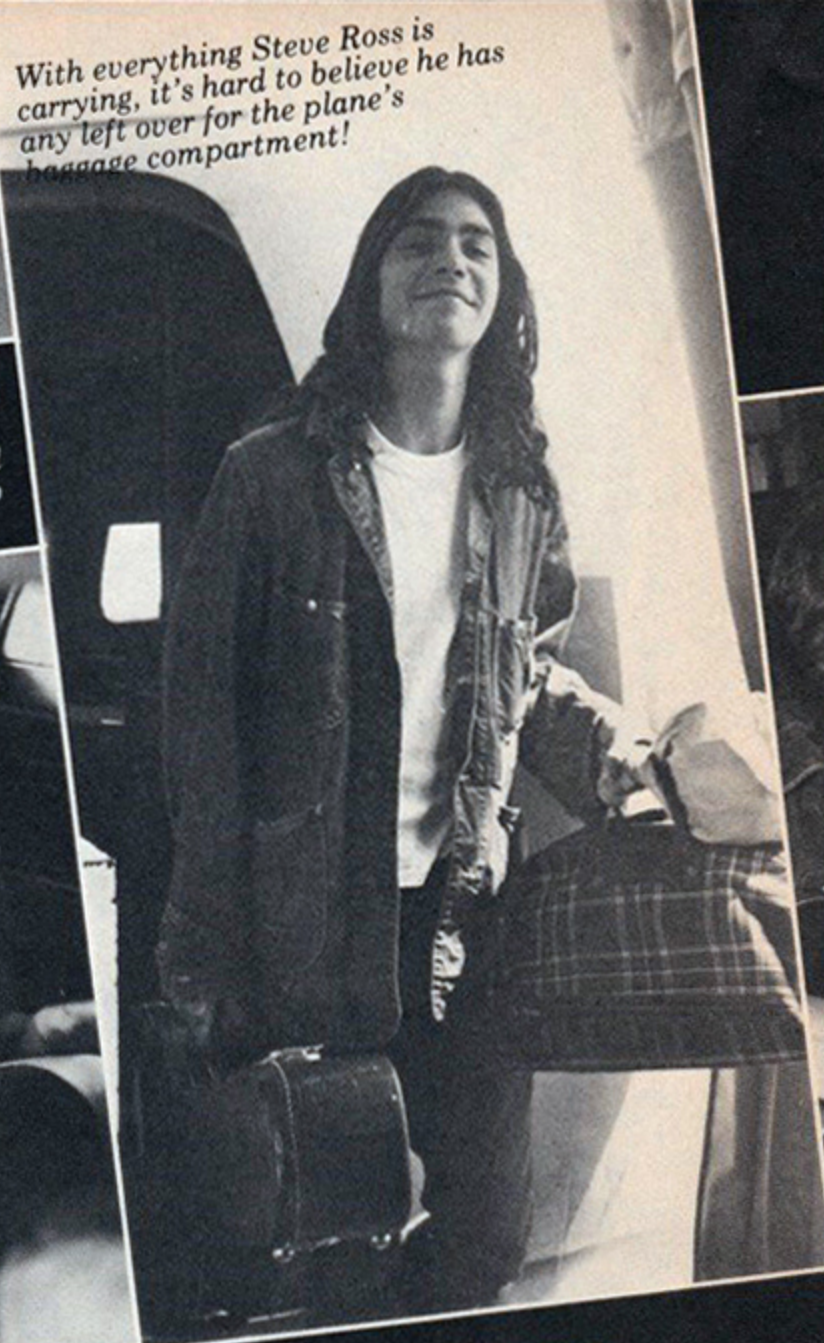


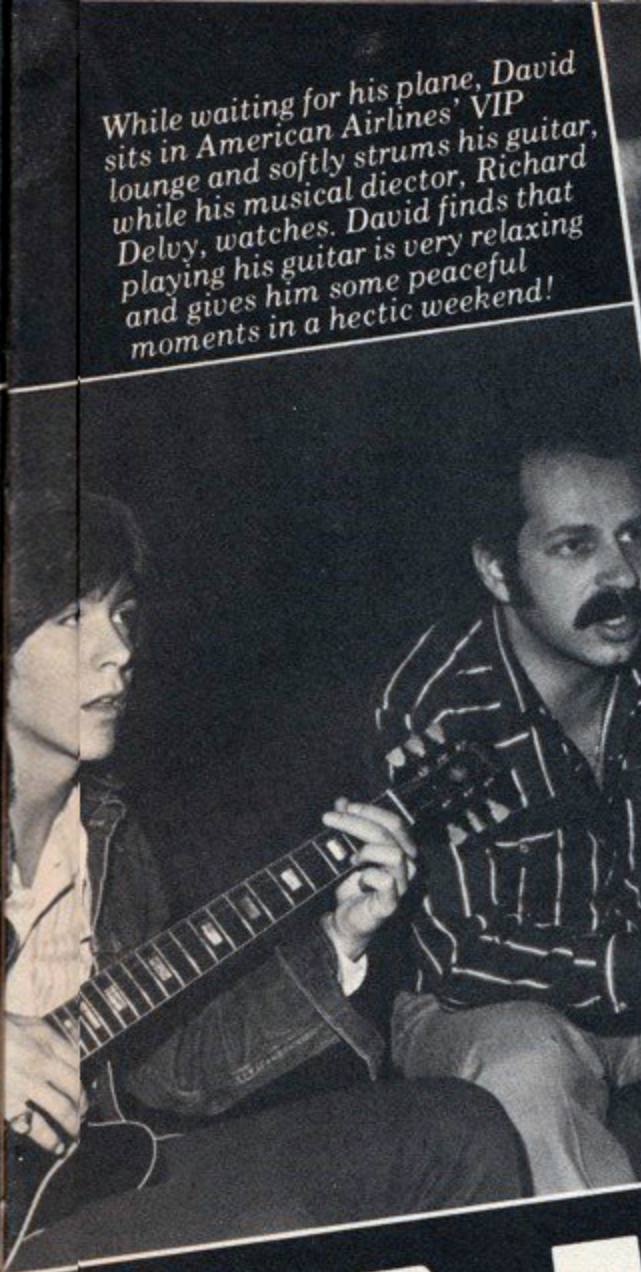


After the press conference, David goes outside to his car.

Two enterprising fans have found David's car, so he invites them to take a short drive with him!



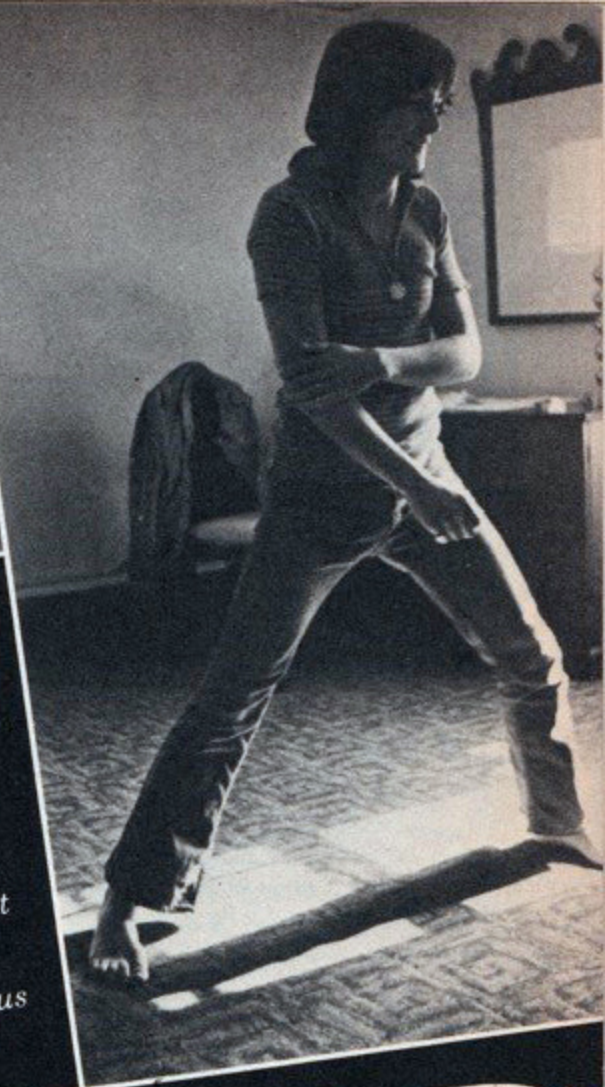
With everything Steve Ross is carrying, it's hard to believe he has any left over for the plane's baggage compartment!
