



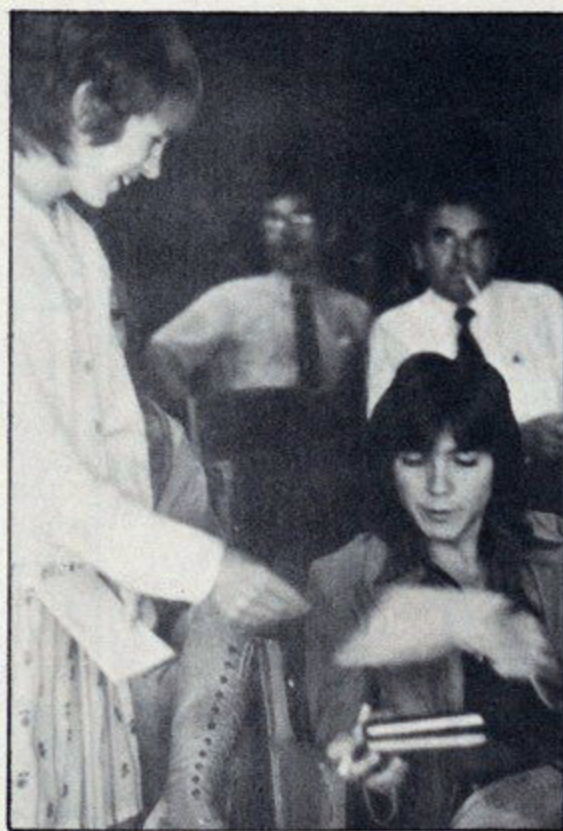
In one of the funniest segments of the show, Glen indignantly
