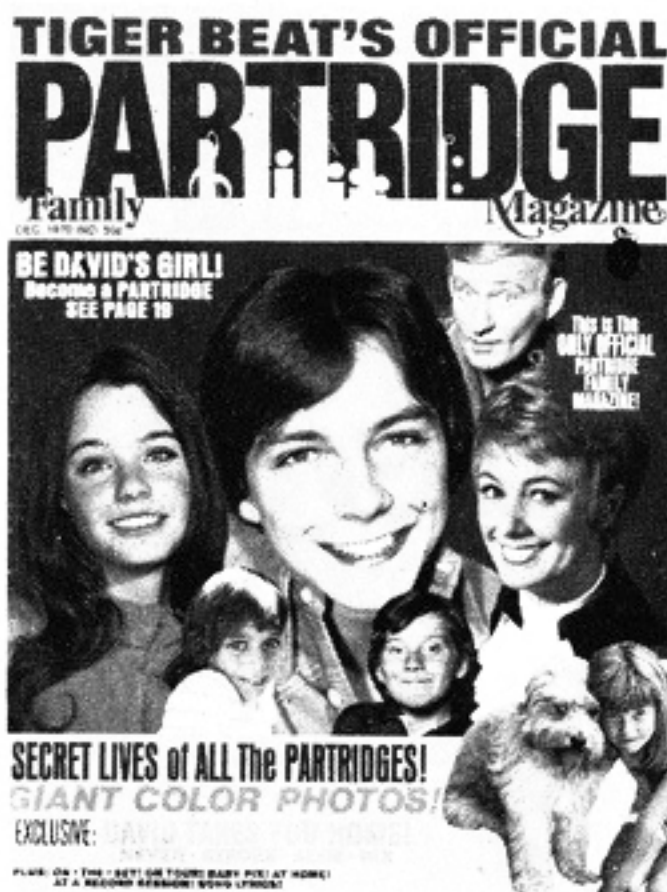
Dear Treena,
