

What David Thinks & Feels ON STAGE!

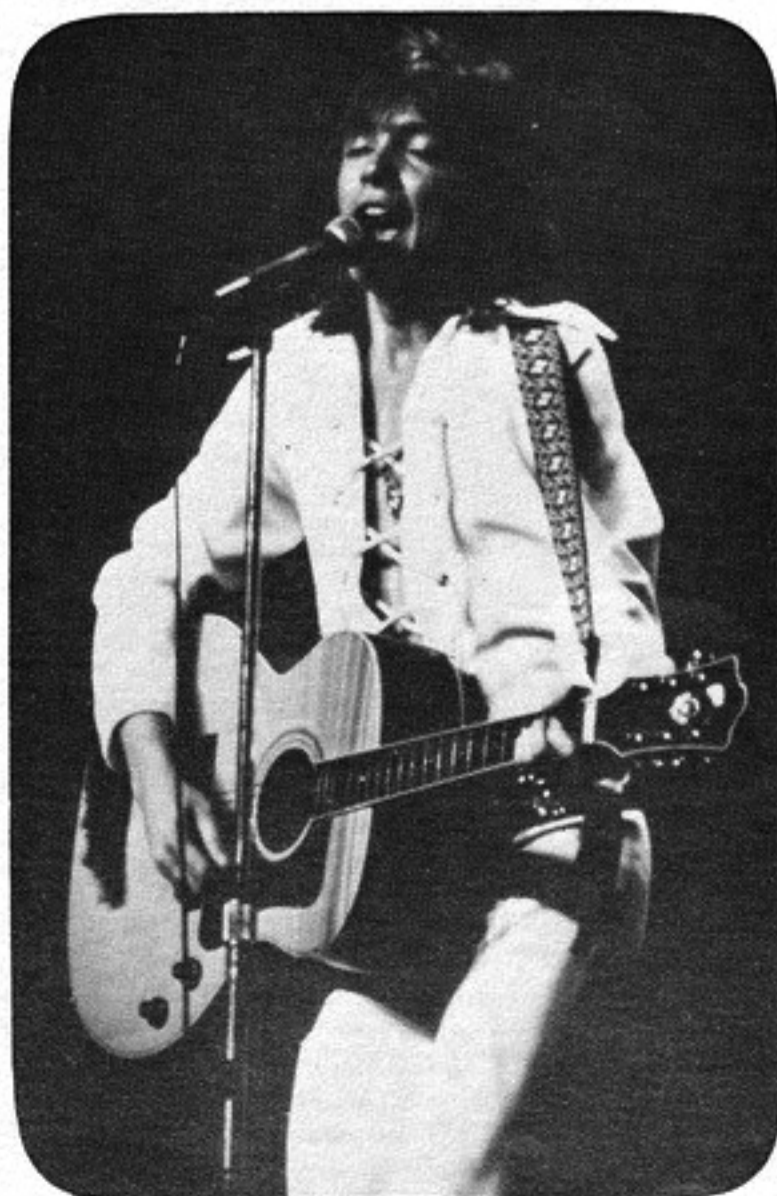
