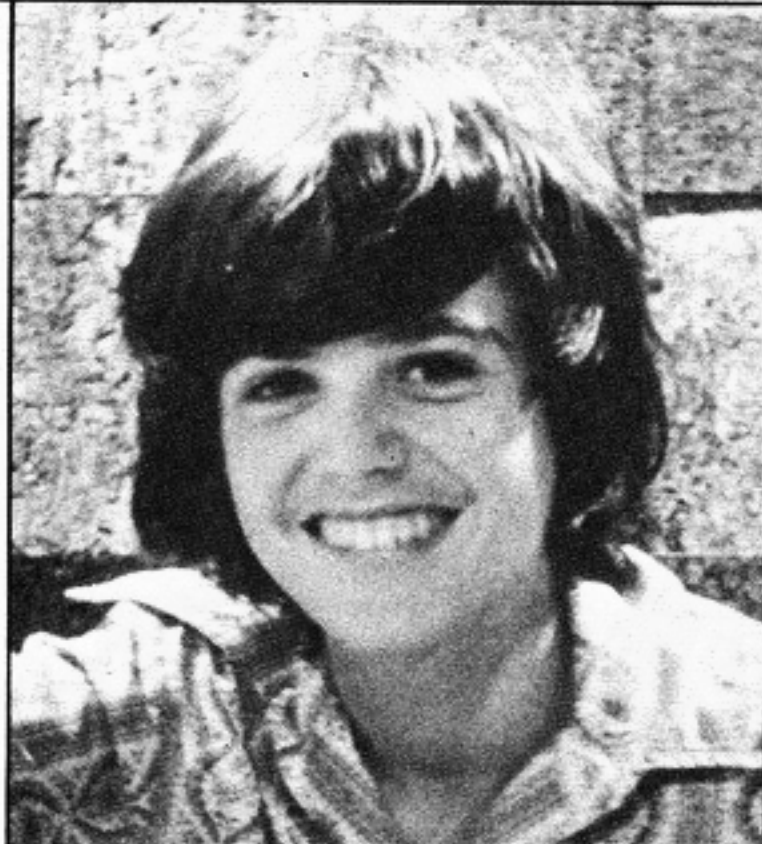


DEAR CAROL

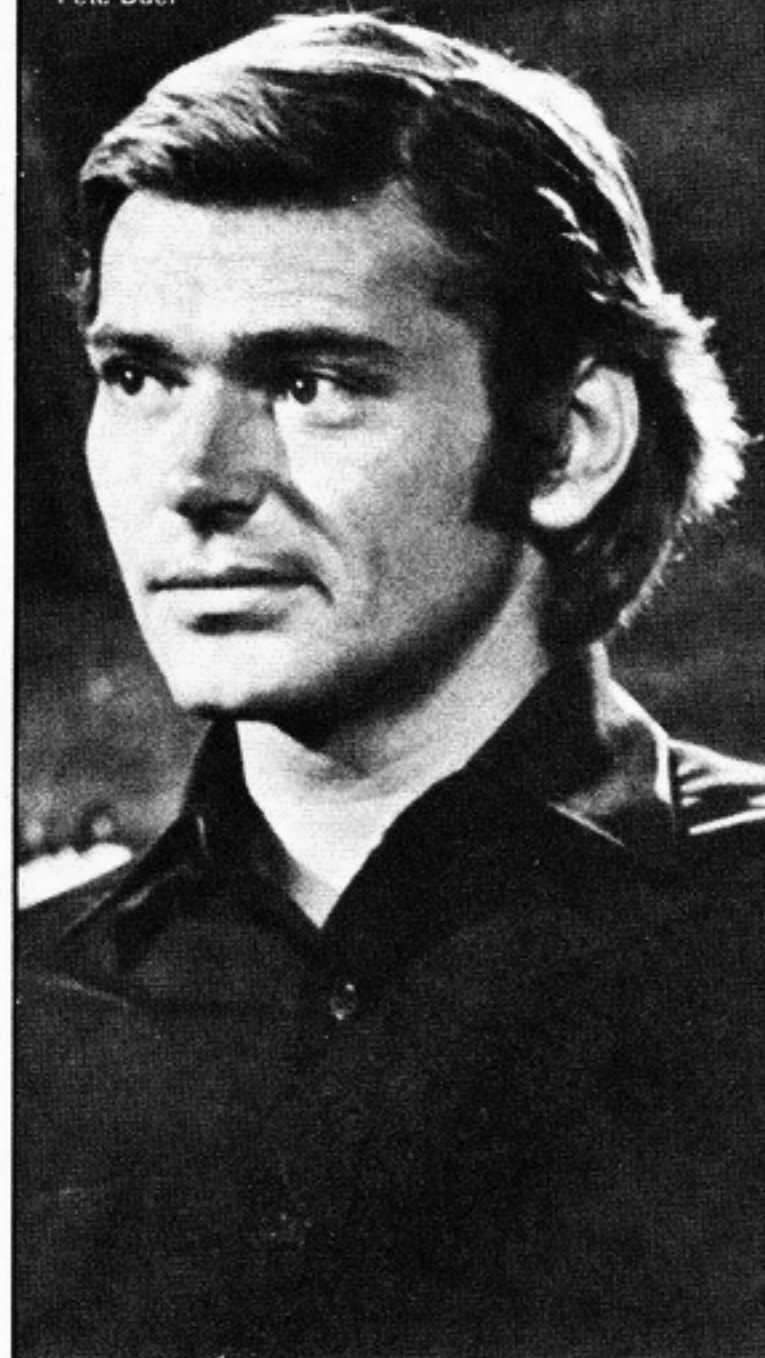
Q. Can you please tell me the birthdate and zodiac sign of Dennis Provisor of the Grassroots? T.T.—Dayton, Ohio
