Then he'll look up, and the love and pleasure in his face actually makes him seem to glow!

We both hope someday some photographer will snap a picture of him at that moment! We'd hang it on **our** wall—neither of us has ever seen a performer with an expression like that, even though we're been entertaining for a few years!

But at the same time, he worries about his fans, and that wears him down, too. All the time he's onstage, while he's singing and dancing around, he's watching the audience, waiting for the thing he fears most—a rush toward the stage!
