A. No, it's not true.


Q. I was wondering if Tige Andrews attended Michael Cole's wedding. I.K.—Stanford, Conn.

A. Well, don't die! You can write to her at 6311 Yucca St., Hollywood, Calif. 90028.


Q. I heard Mark Lindsay died of an overdose of drugs. Could you tell me if this is true? C.R.—Htgn., Ind.
