

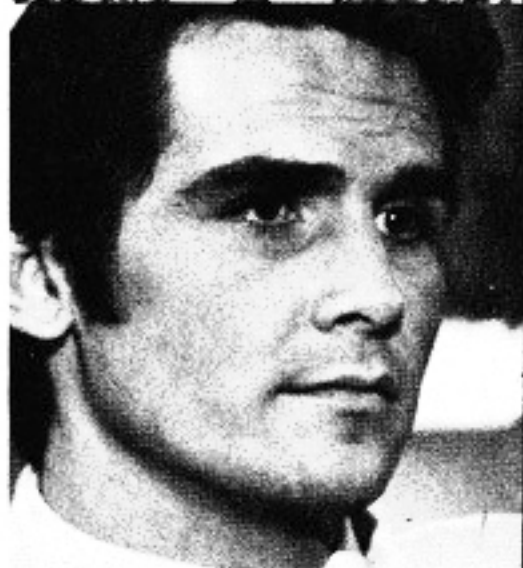


# PERSONAL LIFE

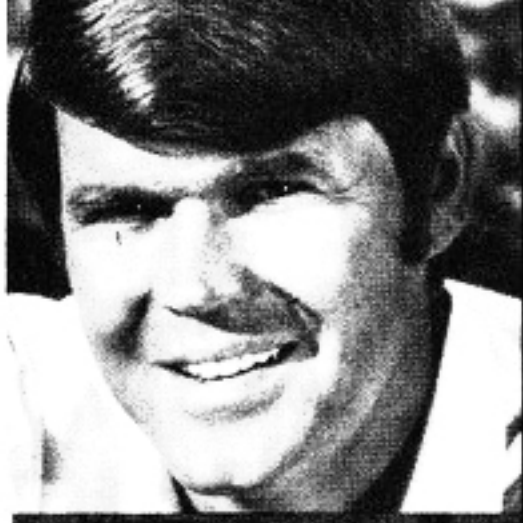
## JAMES BROLIN
