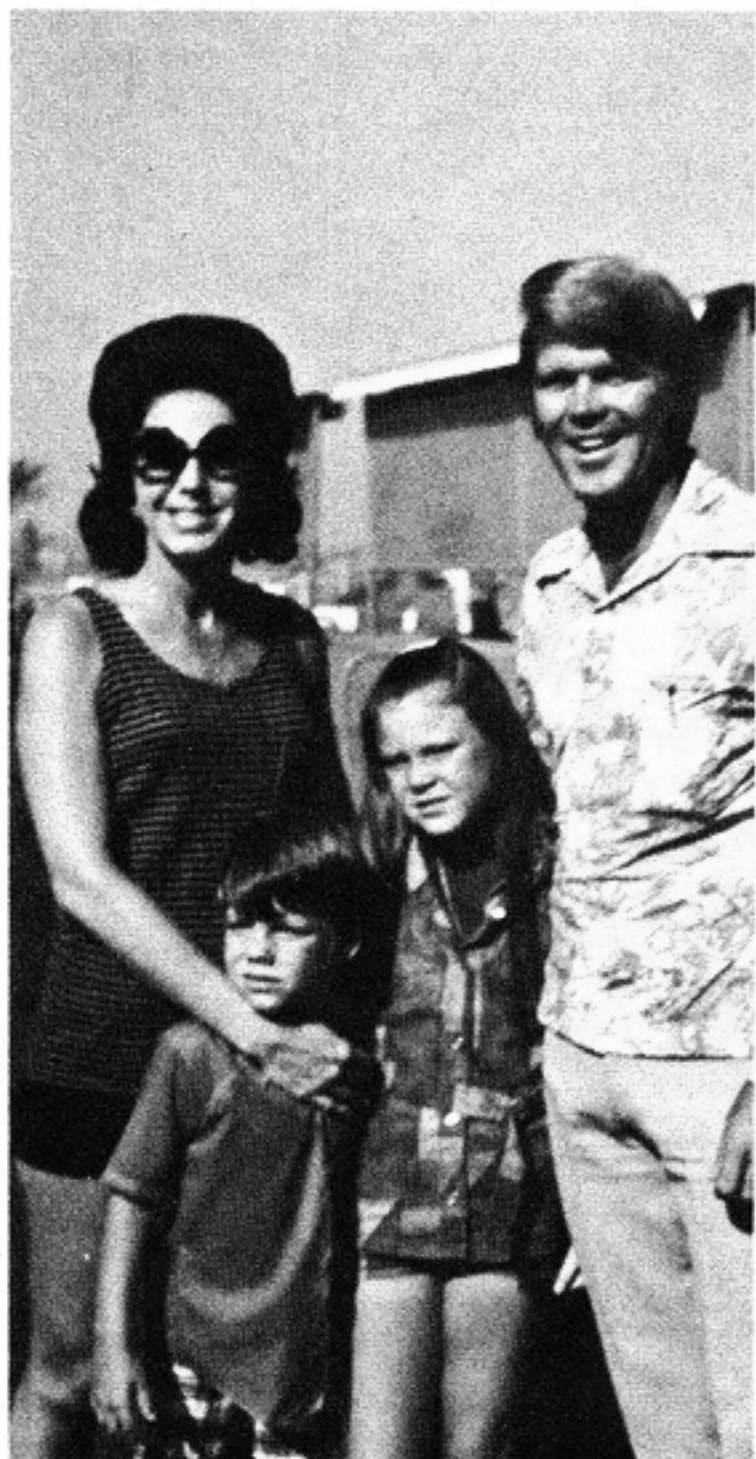


THE NOW HOLLYWOOD
