

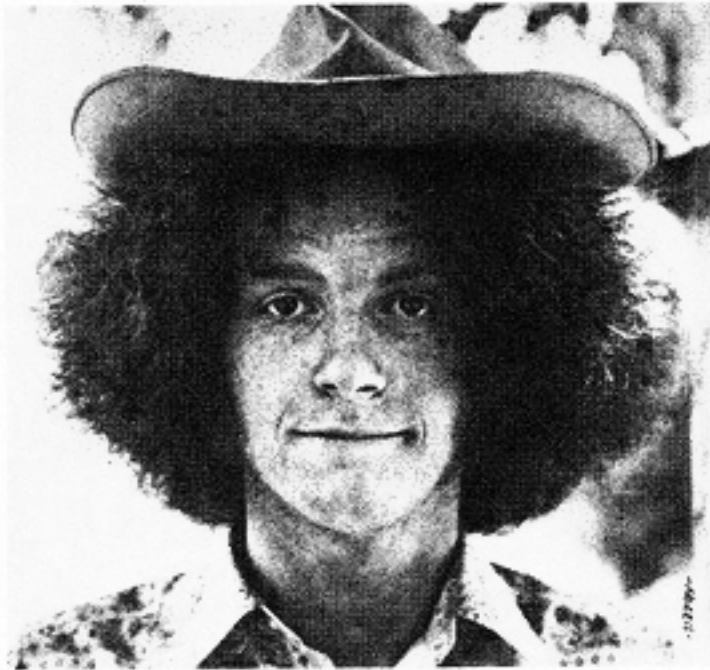
pilot as a spin-off on "Love American Style." I forgot to mention his name—it's **ANSON WILLIAMS**, and don't YOU forget it!

The Hollywood Women's Press Club Golden Apple awards, held at the Bever-



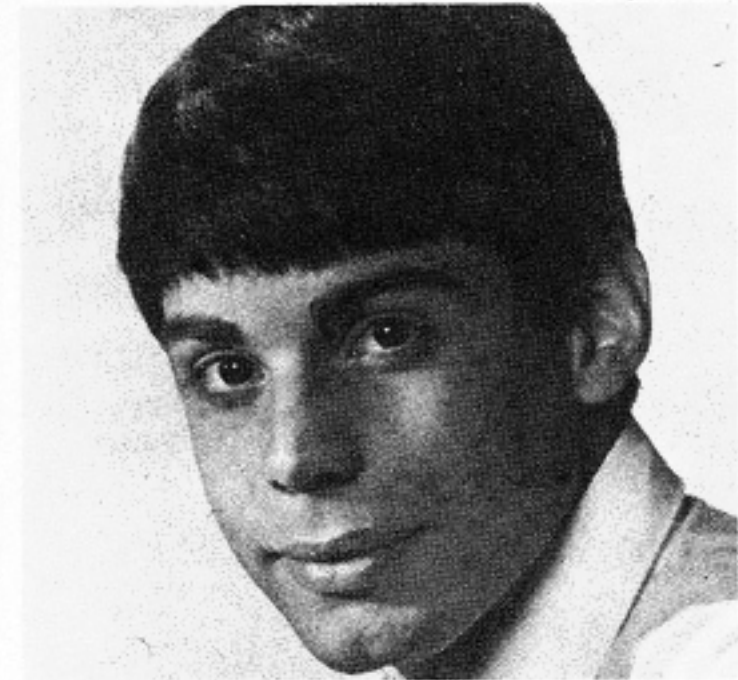
Ex-Monkee Mickey Dolenz was spotted at an Osmond concert and mobbed by adoring fans.
