

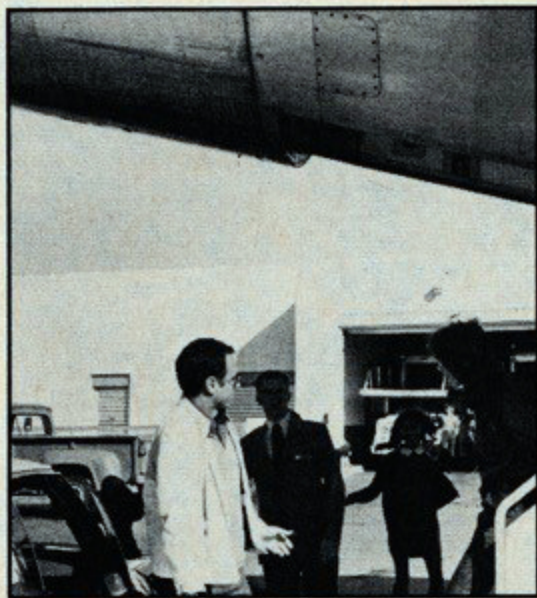
Dear Kim and Dave,
