### TERRIFIC MAGAZINE

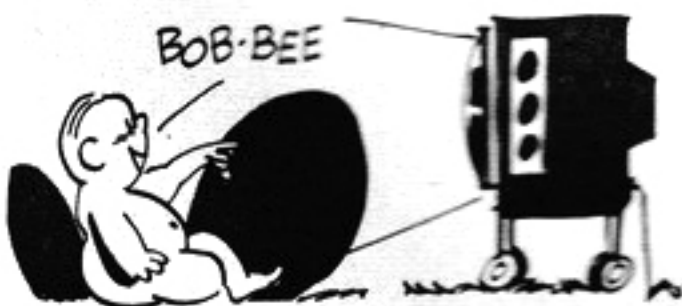
