

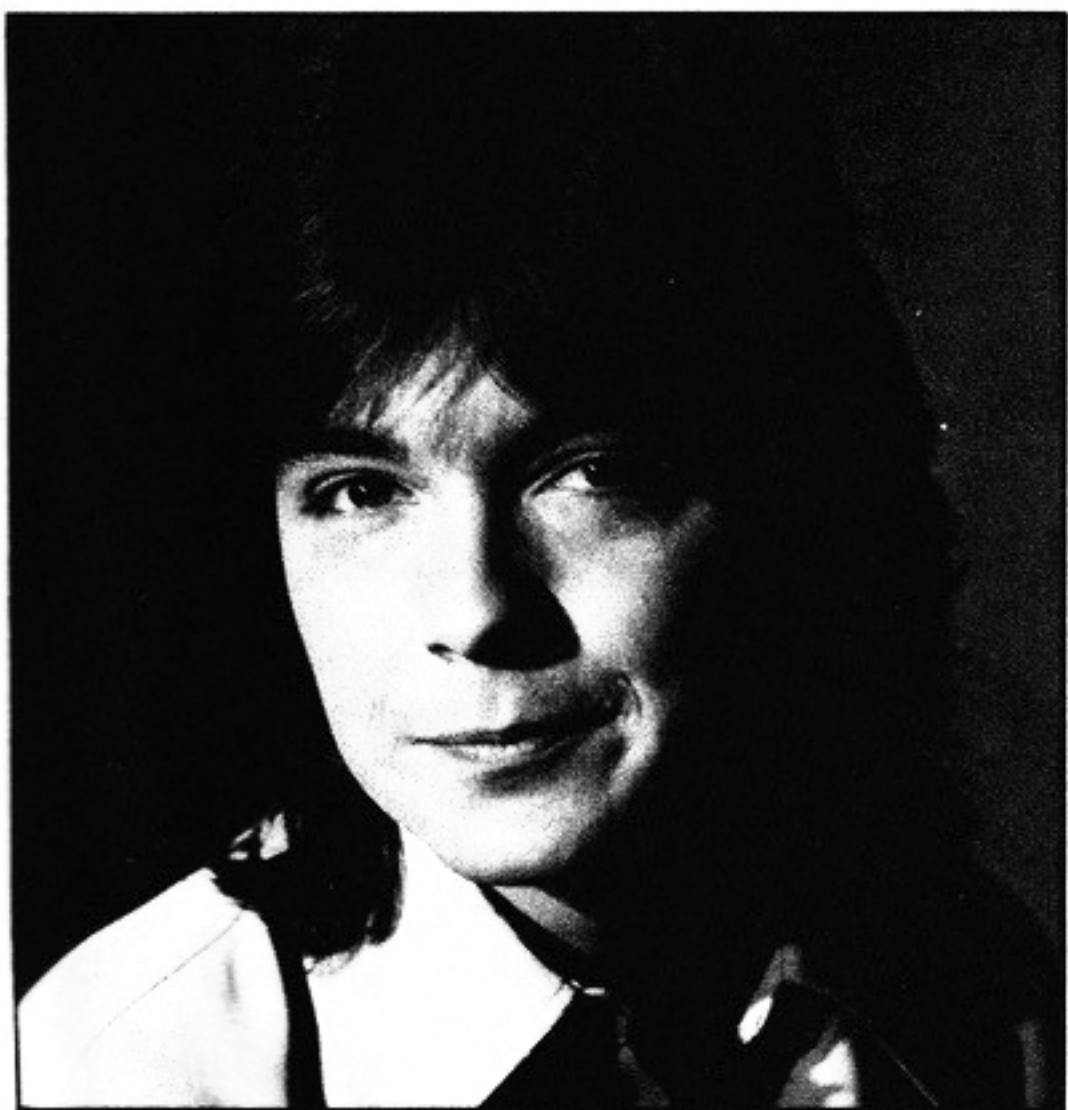
DAVID: Is He A Good Lover?
