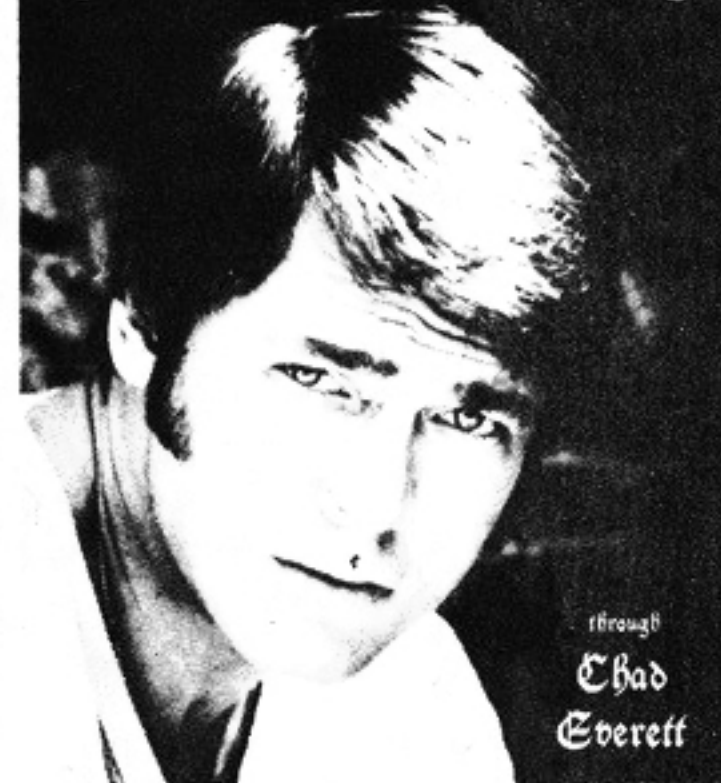
GUESS WHO FANNY
