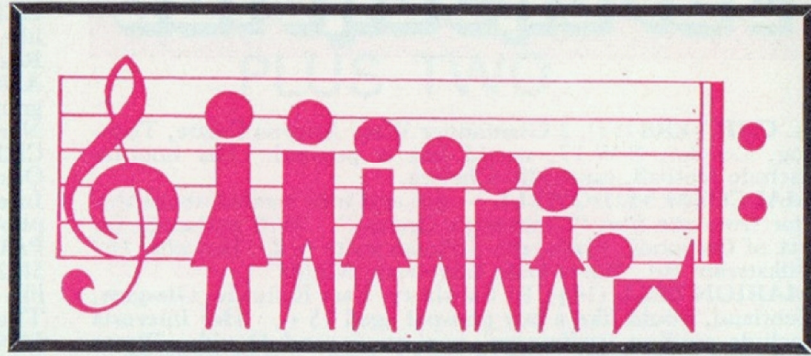


# PARTRIDGE FAMILY FAN CLUB
