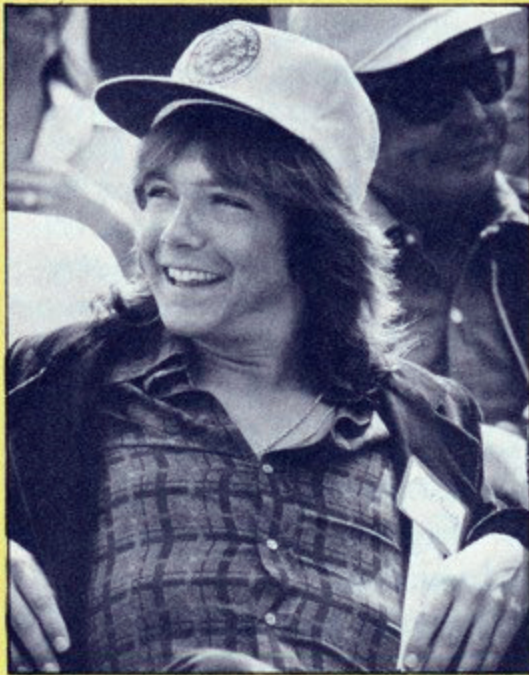


DAVID'S OTHER SIDE!
