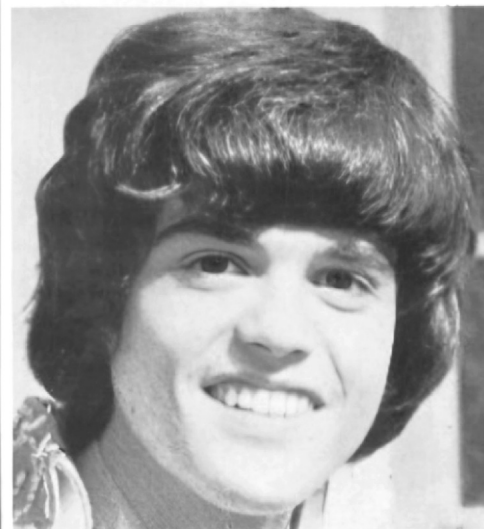
For all you non-believers, Karen did come over to us for a chat, and it was very pleasant talking to her.

Bet you're really sweet, because you're the tastiest boy around!

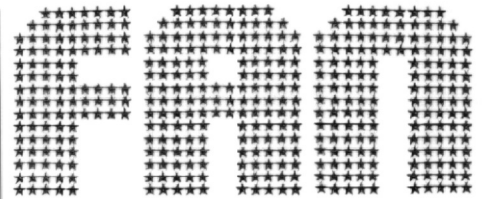
