Q. Would you please tell me where I could write to Andy and David Williams? C.C.—Idaho Galls, Ida.


A. Certainly—you can write to them at P.O. Box 4188, North Hollywood, Calif. 91606.

A. No, that wasn't our Rick. But keep reading FLIP and we'll let you know where you can see Rick.




Q. Does Donny know how to ride horses? L.T.—Deland, Fla.
