Soak picture in water about four hours or longer, then place face down on smooth surface. Gently rub backside with a piece of nylon net. All the paper comes off and leaves a thin, clear sheet with the picture

on it!

Rub on a coat of Decal-It and apply picture to candle. Rub out all wrinkles. Let dry about six hours.

Rub on a coat of Protect-It and let dry completely. As the candle is used, the pictures light up! You can even fill the center up with wax again (be sure to add a new wick, too).
