The console size is approximately 18" x 13" x 8" and speakers approximately 13 1/8" x 9" x 6".

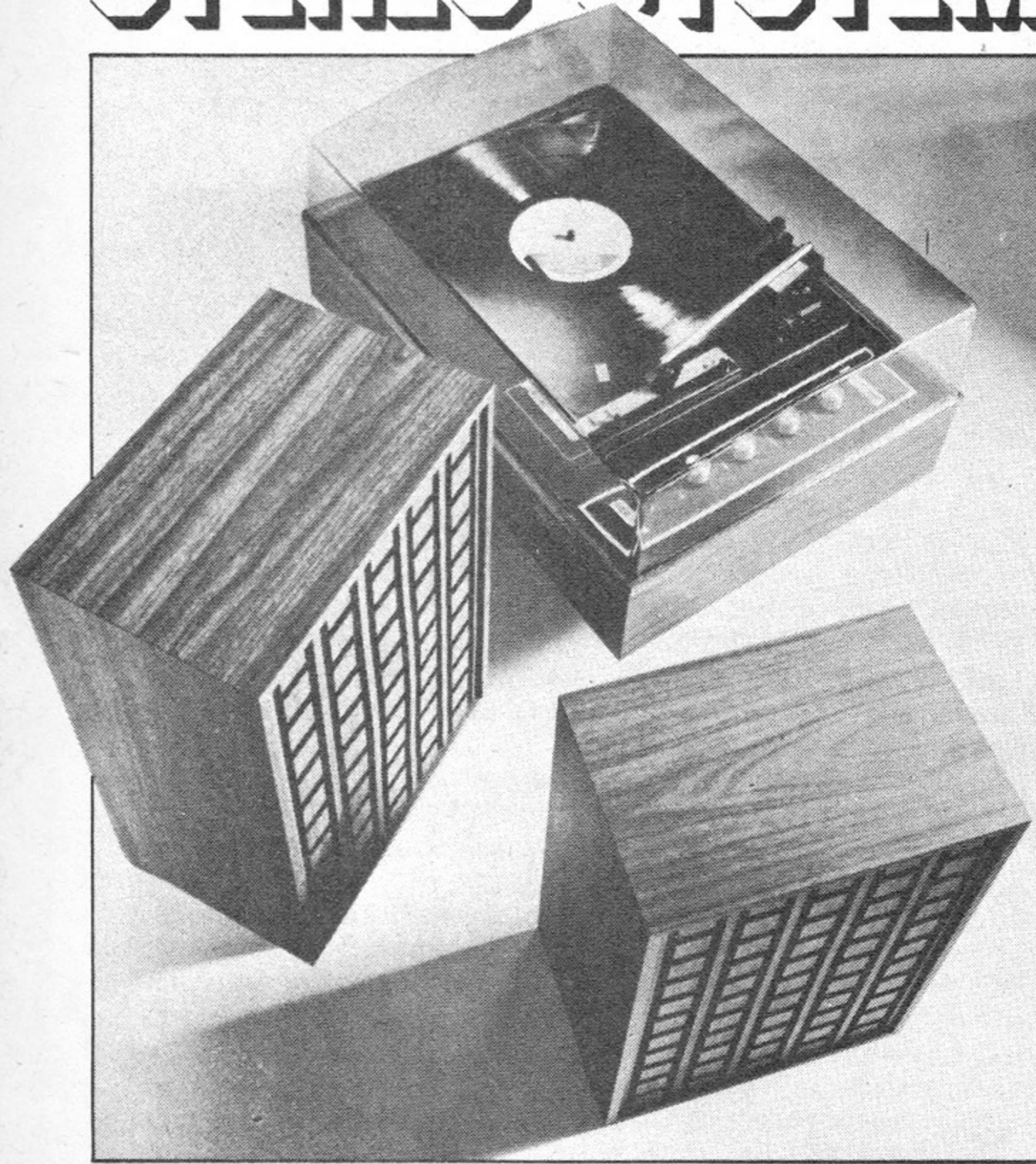
The Wien Stereo 66 is entirely produced in the U.K. and sells for over £40.
