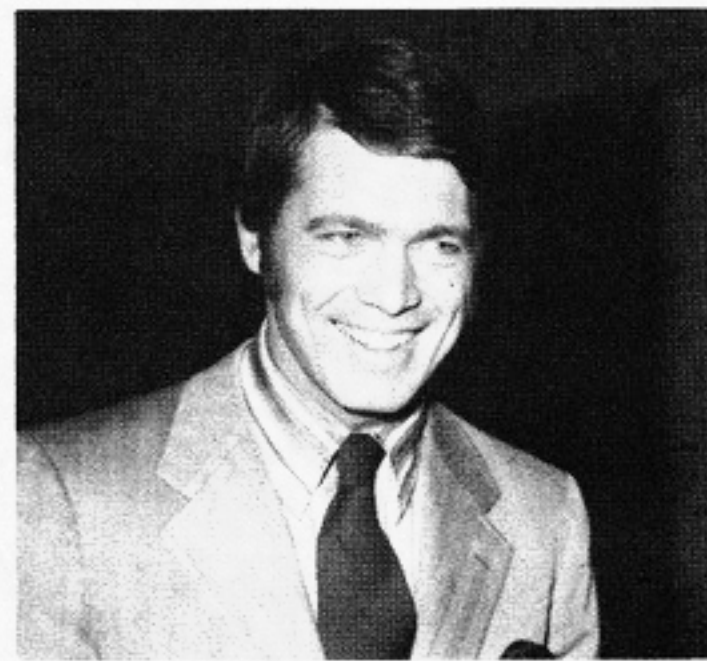
Dear Caryl:
