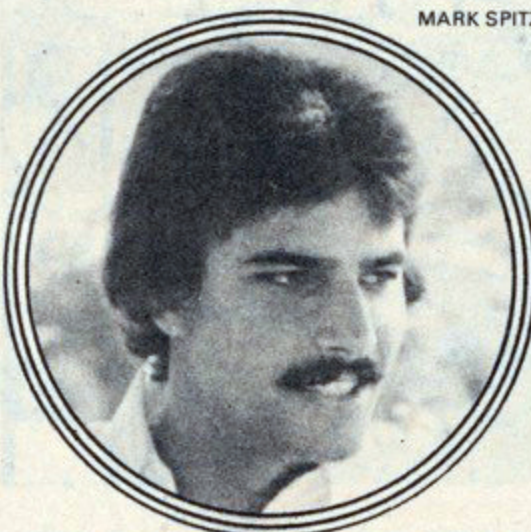


Q. Is Larry Knechtel in the group Bread? If so, why does he play for Seals and Crofts too? L.F.—O.P., Kan.

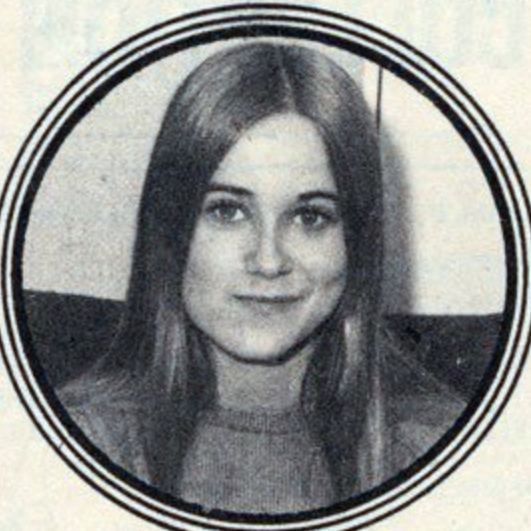
A. Yes, Larry is in Bread but he is also one of the finest session musicians around and he often plays on other people's records.
