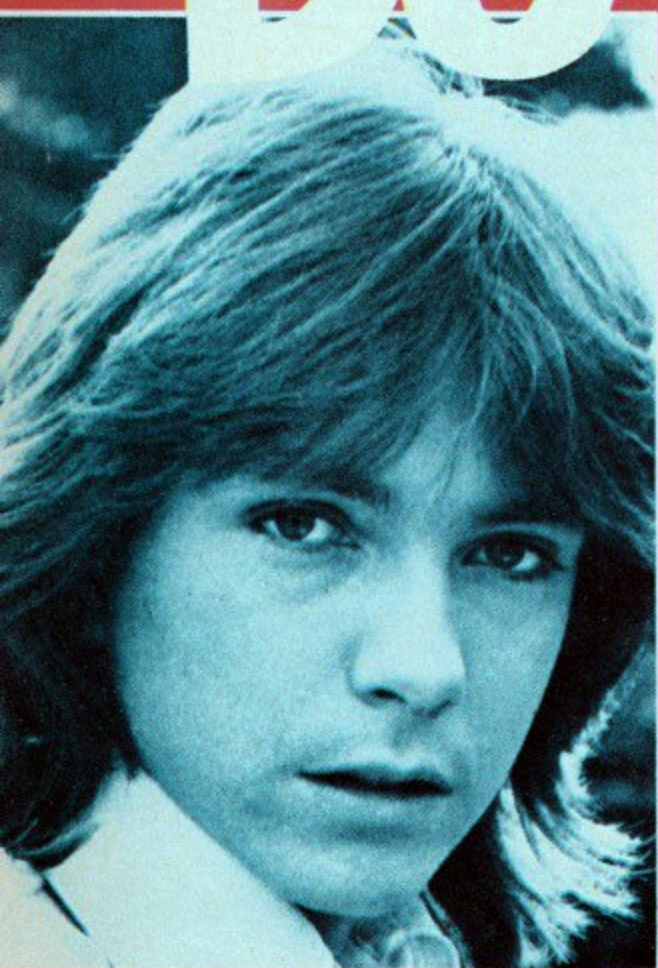


"WHAT DO I DO NOW?"
