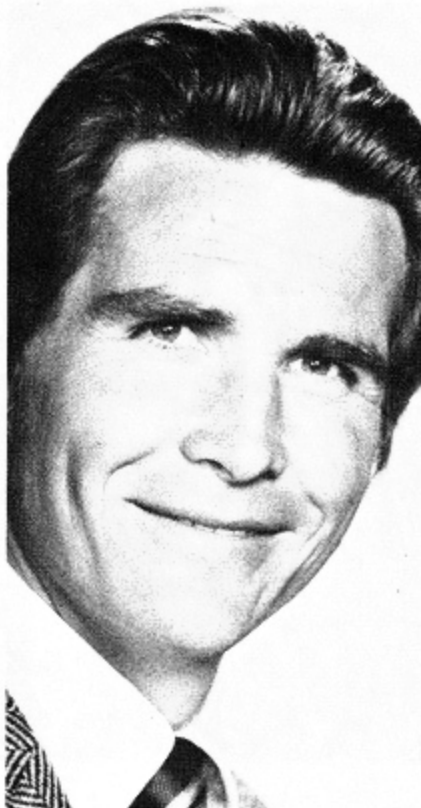




DANNY BONADUCE

Danny and Dave Madden, who plays the Partridge Family's sympathetic and long-suffering agent, are great friends. Danny is the youngest of 4 children and hails from a TV writing family. He began his acting career at the tender age of 6 on commercials, branched out to do guest appearances.



MIKE COLE
 A man in search of himself is the best way to describe Mike Cole and the character he plays on TV's "The Mod Squad," Pete Cochrane. Both charismatic young men reflect an intense independence and strong integrity. Long a wanderer in search of himself, Mike was born in Madison, Wis., on July 3 and was educated through high school there. When his family pulled up stakes and moved to Milwaukee, Mike struck out alone, went to Chicago, then Las Vegas, then San Francisco before arriving in Los Angeles where his future career was decided. Two years of intensive acting lessons led to feature roles on TV and ultimately "Mod Squad." Mike is wed.



JAMES BROLIN
 He flies through the air with the greatest of ease; the only thing is in mid-flight Jim gave up his high-flying career as an aeronautical engineer to try the highly touted career of acting. Somewhere along the way Jim worked in his father's construction firm to pay for his acting lessons but that investment obviously paid off in the shape of an Emmy as best supporting actor in a series. Now as the dedicated and semi-rebellious Dr. Steven Kiley on "Marcus Welby, M.D.," Jim has little financial worries. If he ever decides to quit acting, there's his lucrative mini-ranch where he raises Appaloosa horses for fun and profit.



SUZANNE CROUGH
 Nine-year-old (birthdate March 6, 1963) Suzanne Crough (pronounced Crow) is both the youngest member of her TV "Partridge" clan, as well as the youngest of 8 children in her real-life family. The acting bug bit Suzie while watching her older brothers, Pat and Tim audition for parts. They moved on to acting in commercials. A very gregarious gal, Suzanne makes friends easily. Aside from the human variety, Suzie's friends include her rabbit, Cotton, and three guppies. She's very sports-minded, loves football, baseball and swimming.



DAVID CASSIDY
 Is it lonely at the top? David has been too busy to contemplate such a serious matter. As one of the top teen idols for the last two years, David Cassidy has pleased millions with his recording gigs and appearances as Keith on "The Partridge Family." A crowd-pleaser from way back, David comes by his show business talent naturally as the son of musical comedy star, Jack Cassidy and actress, Evelyn Ward. David spent lonely years growing up when his parents divorced. His dad went on to Hollywood while David and his mom lived in New Jersey. Broadway saw David the actor first—but only briefly.



SUSAN DEY
 Those might be wedding bells you hear in the background. Susan and Dale McRaven have pledged their troth romantically, emotionally and eternally. Dale, one of the most talented young Hollywood writers, is a script consultant for "The Partridge Family" where Susan toils as Laurie P. They became more than friends when Dale offered to coach Susan for a concert tour she and Danny Bonaduce were putting together. Before "Partridge," Susan was a top teen model—her face appearing on the covers of "Seventeen," "American Girl" and "Simplicity" magazines.
