Your answer is important to David, and he's waiting to hear from you. Why not let him know today whether or not you can still love him—even though he's not the same David he was when you met.

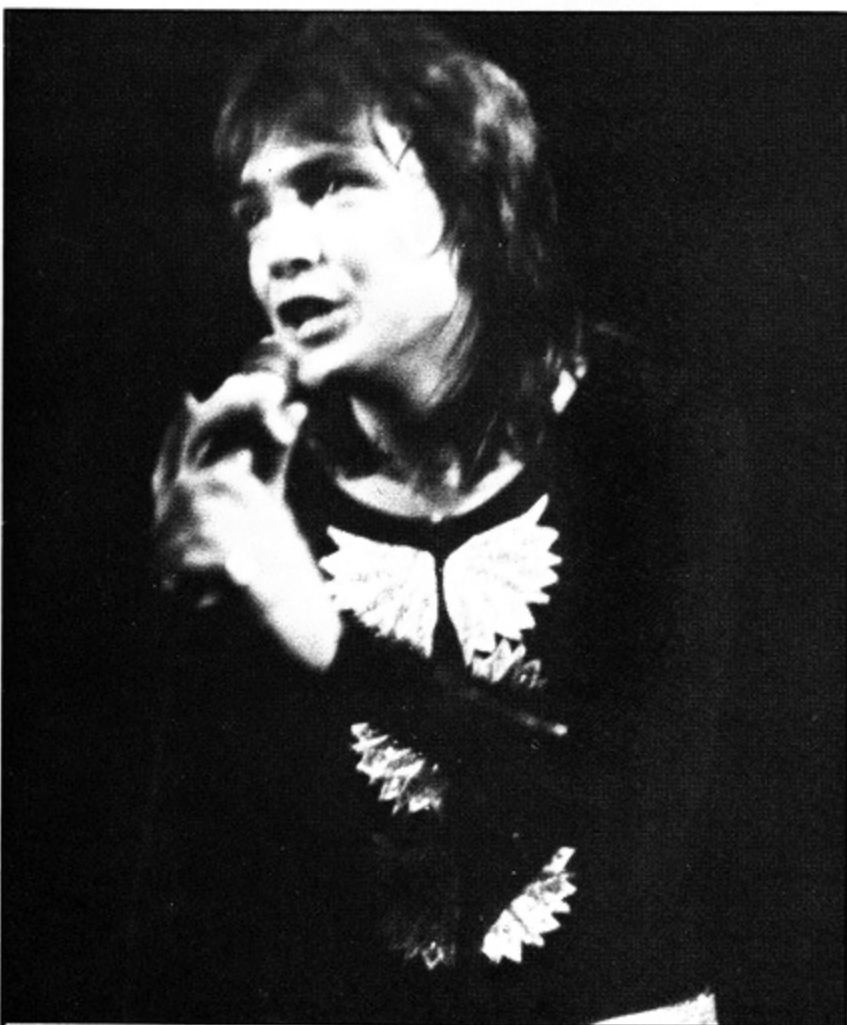


DON'T LOVE HIM?
