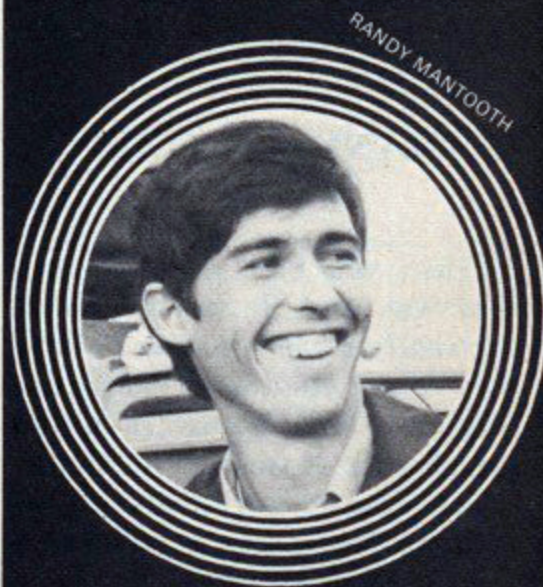
Q. My boyfriend looks just like Michael Gray. Is Mike married? If so, what's her name? P.L.E.—Freehold, New Jersey
