## What Will They Do Now?



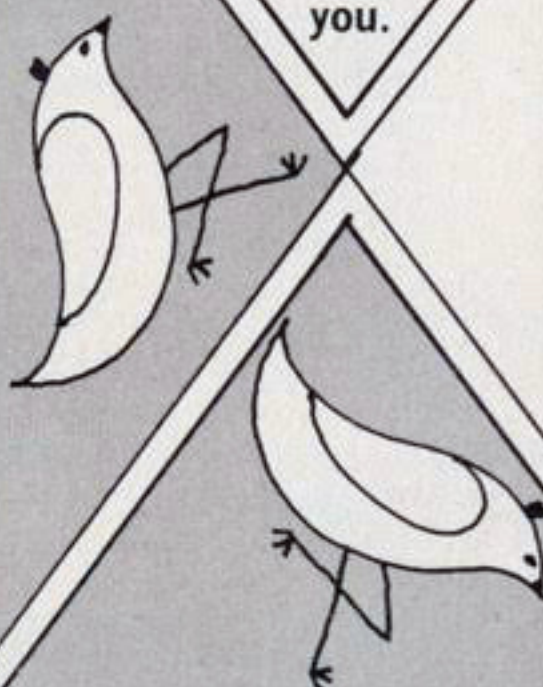
### DAVID CASSIDY

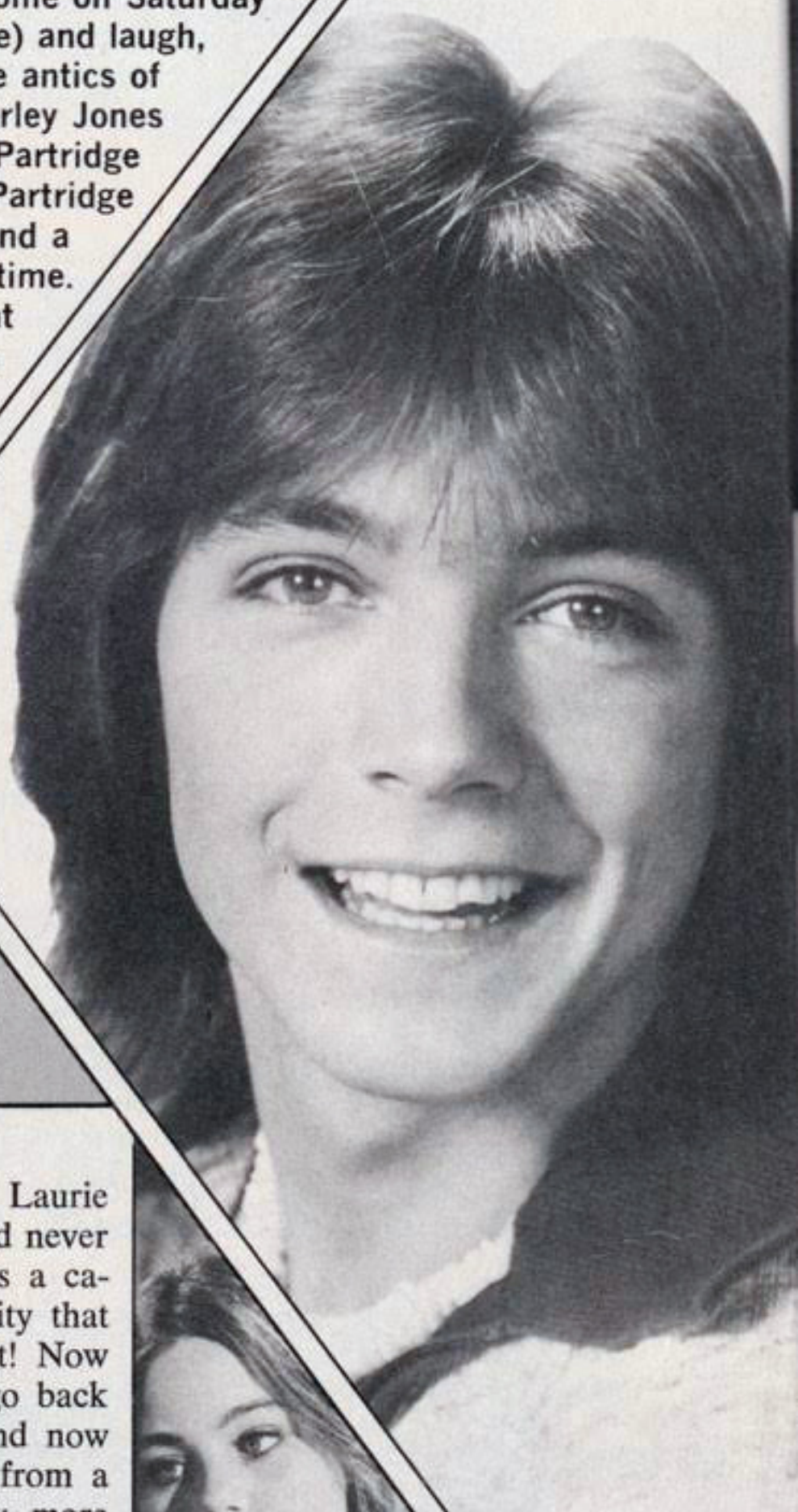
