A. Eve turned 15 on April 29 of this year.

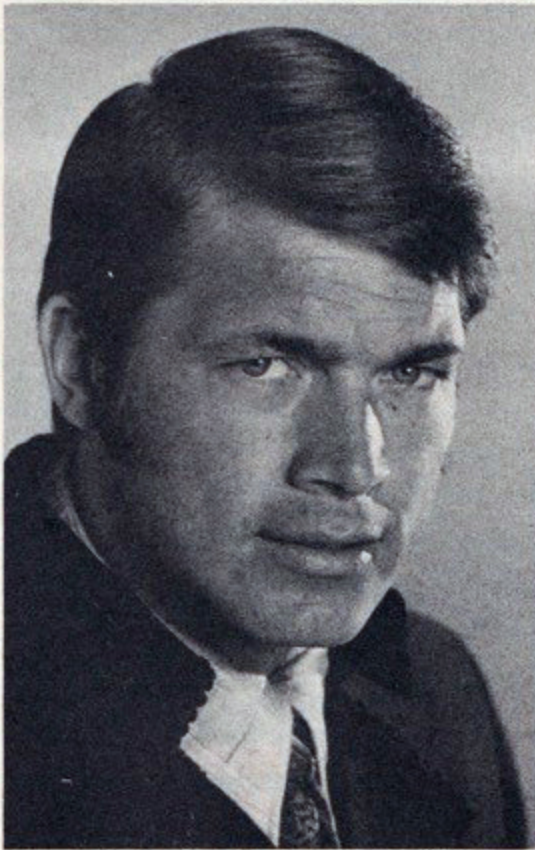
