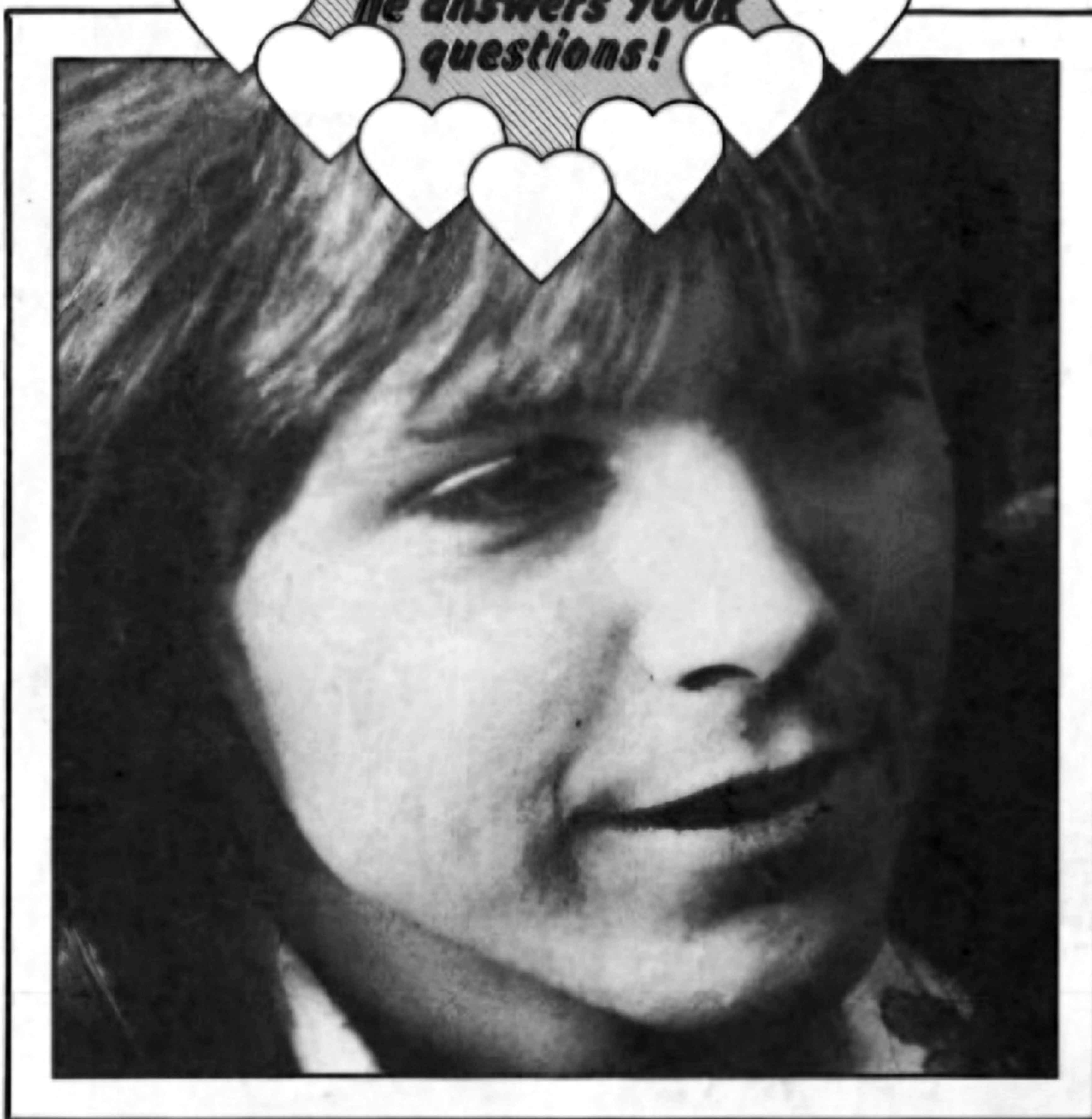
I am really glad we have this opportunity to get together with you all again to answer some more of your questions, and maybe correct some of the crazy misinformation that some people write about me.
