Cassidy has chosen as her debut single a hip-hop-inflected remake of her pop's signature song, "I Think I Love You." The effort is certainly creative and parts of it are good fun, but the remake doesn't work on all fronts. For one, young Cassidy has a sweet, youthful voice that just isn't convincing amid the contemporary, somewhat streety instrumentation. And a rap in the center of the song is simply ill-conceived—Cassidy sounds about as down with it as a peanut butter and jelly sandwich on a hotdog bun. Still, Cassidy also has the good looks to do some heartbreaking among the teen ranksmust be in the family genes—so it will be interesting to see what's next in line.—CT
