In my Florida paradise I can leave my alcohol past behind me

FREIZEIT REVUE visited the former teenie star in Ft Lauderdale, talked to him about his failed marriages, drug excesses and how his new family brought him back to the right track.



In the 70's David Cassidy became famous to the world

Slightly surprised, but with his distinctive smile, DC (60) opens the door. He still is in his bathrobe.

"You're already here?" he asks the FR team. "Come in, make you feel at home. I'm just getting changed."

Uncomplicated. After July, puppy Mickey and parrot Bailey greeted/saluted the guests, the host appears. Jeans, open shirt, sneakers.

The native New Yorker is in top form, still comes

across as a teenager. "Do people in Germany still remember me?" he wants to know. "I'm a big fan of the Germans. Cars, science, research. I just love that."

How did he manage to stay young? "I play golf, jog at the beach, work lots and don't eat red meat", DC says. At a height of 1.72m (5'65") he only weighs 63kg (138.8lbs).

Workaholic. Today the popstar, who used to be more successful than Elvis in the 70s, sporadically performs in concerts. On April 12, he performs in London, celebrates the 40th anniversary of his first visit to Europe.

"Who didn't take drugs back then?" David repels. "John Lennon was my big idol.

But seriously, I don't believe in drugs. They only do harm and make people unproductive."

Hope. What about alcohol? Just recently David lost his license because of alcohol. Here David blocks "I rarely drink.

That doesn't appeal to me anymore", he thoughtfully says. But immediately he smiles again.

"Here in my paradise I eventually can leave all this behind."
