

Girls March For TV Return Of 'Partridge'

LONDON — More than 1000 irate teenage girls staged a march on the BBC-TV Centre on May 13 demanding the return of "The Partridge Family" TV series and its star David Cassidy. The show was dropped by the BBC last Dec. after 13 episodes.

Over 13,000 letters have already been written to the BBC further supporting the girls' cause for the show's return.

Record sales continue to reflect Cassidy's popularity in England. His single, "Could It Be Forever," which was released there only seven weeks ago, is currently number three on the British charts.
