Bell Rushes Cassidy LP

NEW YORK — Bell Records is rush releasing "Cassidy Live!" by David Cassidy, recorded on location at his British concert tour.

Cassidy had announced prior to his British dates that they would be his last public performances for the foreseeable future. The trio of appearances began at Shawfield Stadium in Glasgow, May 24. On May 26, he appeared at White City Stadium in London before a capacity crowd of 45,000. On May 28 he made his final appearance, at Maine Road Stadium in Manchester.

The LP was produced by Cassidy and Barry Ainsworth, and contains "It's Preying On My Mind," co-written by Cassidy, and has Cassidy covering such hits as: Leon Russell's "Delta Lady," The Beatles' "Please Please Me," The Rascals' "How Can I Be Sure," Stephen Stills' "For What It's Worth," the medley of "C.C. Rider Blues/Jenny Jenny," and Neil Sedaka's "Breaking Up Is Hard To Do." The album closes with an extended medley of "Blue Suede Shoes," "Rock Around The Clock," "Rock and Roll Music," "Jailhouse Rock" and Cassidy's version of "Rock Me Baby."
