Cassidy To Resume World P.A. Tour

HOLLYWOOD — A series of European dates on The David Cassidy World Tour '74 concert schedule, originally cancelled because of the "energy crisis," has been reinstated, with four countries back on the tour itinerary.

Beginning in early May, Cassidy will play Stockholm and Gothenberg, Sweden; Copenhagen, Denmark; Rotterdam, Holland; Nad Hamburg, Frankfort, and Munich, Germany.

He'll perform for a total additional audience estimated at some 70,000 people, reaching capacity at all of the halls.

The seven-city swing follows a Cassidy visit to Paris, where he'll tape a television special.

He then travels to Glasgow, Scotland, for a previously set Shawfield Stadium concert for some 15,000, on May 24, followed by the tour capper — a May 26 date at London's White City Stadium.

The 1974 Cassidy tour to date has covered New Zealand, Australia, Hong Kong and Japan. Cassidy presently is taking a breather at his home in Hawaii.
