MIDEM is only the first stop on a worldwide itinerary for Wayne and his professional manager and promotion lady, Gloria. They plan to be in London from January 20-30 and in New York from Feb. 1-7. Wayne plans a brief stopover back home in Los Angeles before heading for Tokyo at the invitation of Kei Takahashi, director of Nichion, in late February, to be followed by a trip to South Africa at the invitation of Peter Gallo, of Gallo Records.

"I've always enjoyed working on an international level," said Wayne. "At last year's Tokyo Music Festival I was able to pick up "Daydreamer" for Warner Bros. and have it cut by David Cassidy. David's version of the song, written by Terry Dempsey of South Africa, became a major international hit, but ironically, never made it in the states. Wayne was also responsible for adding Patti Dahlstrom's American lyric to a Veronique Sanson song and the result is Helen Reddy's new single "Emotion."
