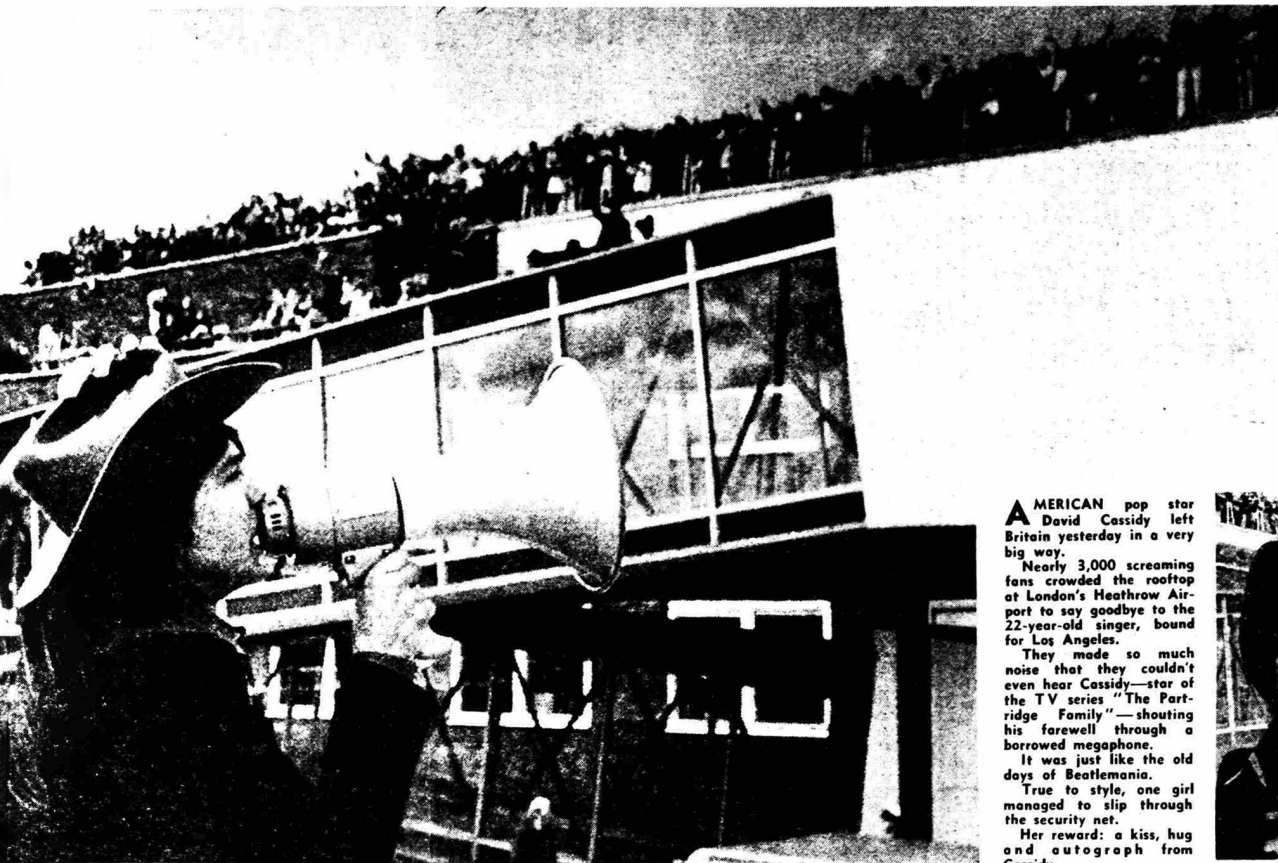


SCREAM-ALONG CASSIDY!
